"Made for This Part 3 - Faithful in the Little" – Nathan Blais

1. What stood out from the message this week?
2. What's a time you felt proud of how you showed up for something ordinary, even when no one noticed?
3. When you hear "be faithful in the little," what's your gut reaction: encouraged, annoyed, tired, motivated—why?

Discuss

4. Read Nehemiah 2:1–2. Then discuss how Nehemiah's long-term consistency shows up in the details of the story, and why that consistency mattered when the moment of opportunity arrived.
5. The sermon framed it as "God's favor" and "our faithfulness" being two sides of the same coin. Where do you see both in Nehemiah 2:1–8?
6. Read Nehemiah 2:4–5. Then discuss what stands out about Nehemiah praying first and then making a clear request—what does that teach us about faith and action working together?
7. The message emphasized that "favor and faithfulness are connected," and that "competency gets you in the room, but character keeps you in the room." What do those statements clarify about leadership and trust?

8. Where are you most tempted to cut corners: effort, honesty, attitude, time, or follow-through—and what's usually driving that?
9. The sermon said, "Nothing stays hidden... hidden sin won't stay hidden, and hidden faithfulness won't stay hidden either." What "in secret" habit (good or bad) do you sense will eventually shape your future in a bigger way?
10. Are you someone worth investing in right now—if another person looked at your patterns (not your potential), what would they conclude about your character and reliability?
