General Fund income for November was above budget. This is encouraging after four consecutive months of below-budget income. General Fund expenses were under budget, giving us a surplus of \$5,864.71 for the month.

Our year-to-date General Fund deficit of more than \$19,000 is much larger than our budget anticipated, but hopefully that deficit will decrease when December's results are compiled. Our General Fund balance maintains our financial grade at an "A." Our White Gift Offering (not part of the General Fund) reached our goal of \$9,500!
