

# The Kind of Prayer That Brings Breakthrough

## Adult Small Group Discussion Questions

- 1 When you hear the phrase “child-like faith,” what comes to mind? In what ways is your prayer life marked by trust, and where do you struggle to fully depend on God?
- 2 The sermon emphasized that we are not the answer—God is. How can self-reliance quietly show up in our prayers?
- 3 Genesis 18:14 asks, “Is anything too hard for the Lord?” What situation in your life feels overwhelming right now, and how does this verse challenge your perspective?
- 4 Matthew 13:58 shows that unbelief limited what Jesus did. What does this teach us about the relationship between faith and experiencing God’s power?
- 5 Jesus says faith as small as a mustard seed can move mountains (Matthew 17:20). What mountain are you praying about, and what step of faith might God be asking you to take?
- 6 According to Matthew 6:5–15, how do motives and attitudes affect prayer? What helps you pray with sincerity instead of routine or performance?
- 7 1 John 3:21–22 connects obedience and forgiveness with confidence in prayer. How do these areas impact your prayer life today?
- 8 What does it mean to truly ask in Jesus’ name (John 16:23–27)? How is this different from simply using the phrase at the end of a prayer?
- 9 Hebrews 11:6 says God is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him. Do you believe this personally, and how does that belief shape your consistency in prayer?
- 10 The disciples asked Jesus to increase their faith (Luke 17:5). What practical step can you take this week to grow in faith and deepen your prayer life?
