



Life Group Study Questions Ecclesiastes 3

1. Read Ecclesiastes 3 together. As you think about this weekend's sermon, what stood out to you? What questions come to mind? Was there anything unclear or confusing?
2. Think about the different seasons of life. What parts of verses 1-8 stuck out the most to you? What "times and seasons" have been most enjoyable in your life? Most difficult?
3. Do you resonate with Qohelet's struggle in wanting to know all the details of the times and seasons God has you in? How do you understand verse 11? Have you felt the tug of eternity and been frustrated in not being able to figure things out?
4. Pastor Andrew's first point was "God determines times and seasons, not you." Are you someone who struggles with having control? Does it bother you knowing that you have very no control over the times and seasons of your life?
5. Read Acts 17:26-27. Why does God allot certain times and seasons and boundaries? Have you seen God drawing you in certain seasons in your own life?
6. Pastor Andrew's second point was "You don't need to know everything." Do you find it hard to trust God when you are in a difficult season? If you feel up for it read Job 38-41 and see how God answers Job's questioning of why these terrible things have happened to him. Does God give Job a straight-forward answer to his questioning? Read Job 42:1-6 to see his response to God's answer.
7. Pastor Andrew's third point was "God works out all times and seasons for the good of those who love him." Why is this crucial to remember when you go through difficult times and seasons that you don't understand? Read Romans 8:26-30 and note all the promises God makes to his people.
