HEBREWS 10:19-25, JOHN 13:31-35

[19] Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus, [20] by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain, that is, through his flesh, [21] and since we have a great priest over the house of God, [22] let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. [23] Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promised is faithful. [24] And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, [25] not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near. (Hebrews 10:19-25 ESV)

[31] When he had gone out, Jesus said, “Now is the Son of Man glorified, and God is glorified in him. [32] If God is glorified in him, God will also glorify him in himself, and glorify him at once. [33] Little children, yet a little while I am with you. You will seek me, and just as I said to the Jews, so now I also say to you, ‘Where I am going you cannot come.’ [34] A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. [35] By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another.” (John 13:31-35 ESV)

Reflection Questions:

1. What are my thoughts on small groups right now? Is there something that is keeping me back from joining one or becoming a small group leader? How does today’s message encourage me to move into a “circle”?
2. Am I relating to church more as a consumer (“I attend, receive, and leave”) or as family (“I belong, share, and build up”)? What habit reveals that most clearly?
3. Jesus says our love will identify us as His disciples (John 13:34–35). What is one small, concrete act of “vulnerable love” I can practice this week?
