Encouraging Words from Pastor Chris

As we get into the first part of 2026 we have two primary points of focus. On February 1 we are beginning a new emphasis on Discipleship Groups. We currently have 19 groups put together that range from 4-6 people. These groups are going to be walking together for the next 12-18 months in daily Bible engagement, journaling, Scripture memory, prayer, and accountability. The primary goal of these groups is to grow each member into a stronger and more faithful disciple who then becomes a disciple maker themselves. These groups are intended to promote a strong commitment to the spiritual

disciplines. While we have 19 facilitators now, at the end of this cycle the idea is that members from each group would then start their own group with new people with whom they live around, work with, and recreate with. This will create a multiplication framework within our church. If we commit to this, I believe God can transform our lives individually which will lead to spiritual transformation and revival within our church

which should carry over into our community.

Another area of focus moving forward is going to be developing our footprint in Connecticut. Our vision team that went up a few weeks ago has been seeking clarity from the Lord as to who we should connect to. I am grateful to share that we have come to the same conclusion as to where God wants us. We believe that there are two works that we can plug in to. Rocco Gammone Jr. is the planter/pastor at On the Rock Community Church in New London, Connecticut. Carlos Correa has recently been approved by NAMB to be a planter and is in the very early stages of planting a Spanish speaking church near the same area. We don't know for sure what these partnerships will look like exactly, but we believe this is where God is leading us in the short term. We are taking a big step of faith by committing to two, but little is much when God is in it. Eventually, we pray that God would allow us to build even greater connections across the state. One way that this can be possible is through partnering with other local churches here in and around Florala. I have already spoken with a few pastors who might be interested in doing so. I would also love for you to begin praying that long term we would be able to plant a church there where we raise up and equip a planter/pastor to send out.

This is an exciting time in the life of our church, and I challenge you to plug in and engage as we work to make disciples from here to the ends of the earth.

SENIOR ADULTS

Pass the Baton

“And how can they believe without hearing about him?” – Romans 10:14b

Track and Field’s 4x100-meter race is a beautiful and precise picture of teamwork. Four runners rely on each other to run full speed while fluidly passing the baton onto the next. After the start, one after the other demonstrates immense talent and agility as they gracefully slip a small baton into the next runner’s hand. But what would happen if the third runner never took off? The fourth and final runner would be waiting, unable to cross the finish line and finish the race.

God has entrusted and given us (**Senior Adults**) a baton of truth to pass along. It isn’t in the form of a plastic or aluminum baton, but in the form of a message: the **GOSPEL** and a **GODLY LIFESTYLE**. In Matthew 28:19-20, Jesus said to His disciples right before He ascended into heaven, “**Go**, therefore, and make disciples of all nations... **teaching** them to observe everything I have commanded you.” He wasn’t just giving this command to the disciples but to us (**Senior Adults**), too! If you are a follower of Jesus, this command is for you.

Jesus is telling us to run this race of life and pass the baton of the Gospel to every person we meet. God’s plan is to use us (**Senior Adults**) to teach people about Him and to live for him. We shouldn’t just pass the baton in church, but we should share the pass everywhere we go.

If we never share the Gospel with others, how will they hear it? It is just like the third runner never taking off to the fourth. If we carry God’s Good News with us daily, why would we not pass it off? Why would we keep a lifesaving message to ourselves? Let us run this race set before us and continue to pass off the baton, sharing the Good News of the Gospel for all to hear.

If it seems a bit scary to share the Gospel, Jesus encourages us in Matthew 28:20, saying, “And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age.” Jesus is telling you to pass the baton, but He is also helping you do it!


