**The Mission Board has designated the Marion Medical Mission as our January Mission of the month.** Thank you for your generosity in giving to Marion Medical Mission in 2025! **Total giving to the Wells Project for 2025 was \$6,573.00, for almost 14 wells!** Eleven wells have already been built in villages in 4 different countries: *Malawi, Zambia, Tanzania and Mozambique*, with a total of 1605 people in those villages now have healthy, clean drinking water. They no longer have to drink water from contaminated streams and waterholes. The lifespan of these 1605 people have been significantly increased because they now have clean water to drink.
