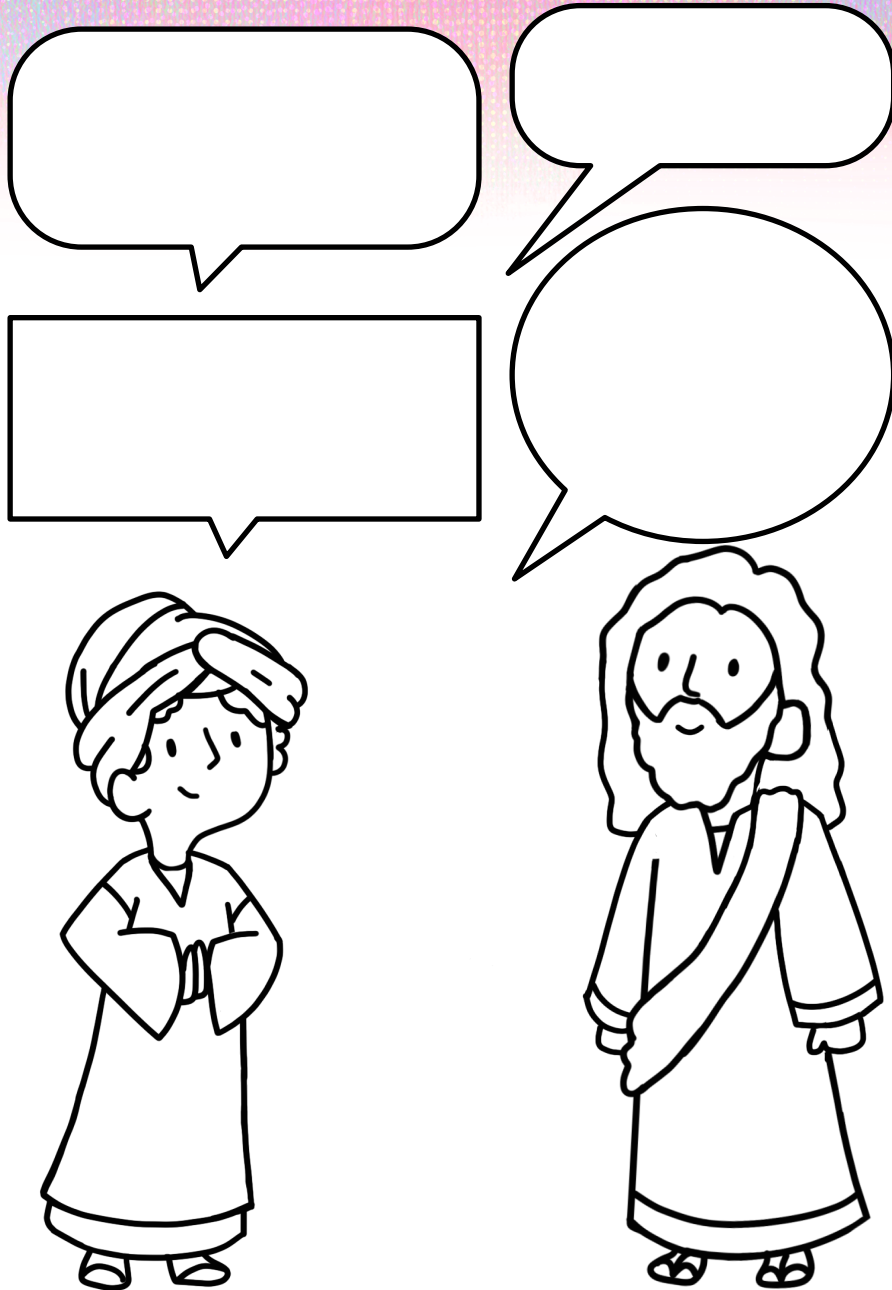


Draw & Color

Nicodemus

When he left Jesus, Nicodemus still didn't understand everything about God. But he knew how much God loved him and all of creation.



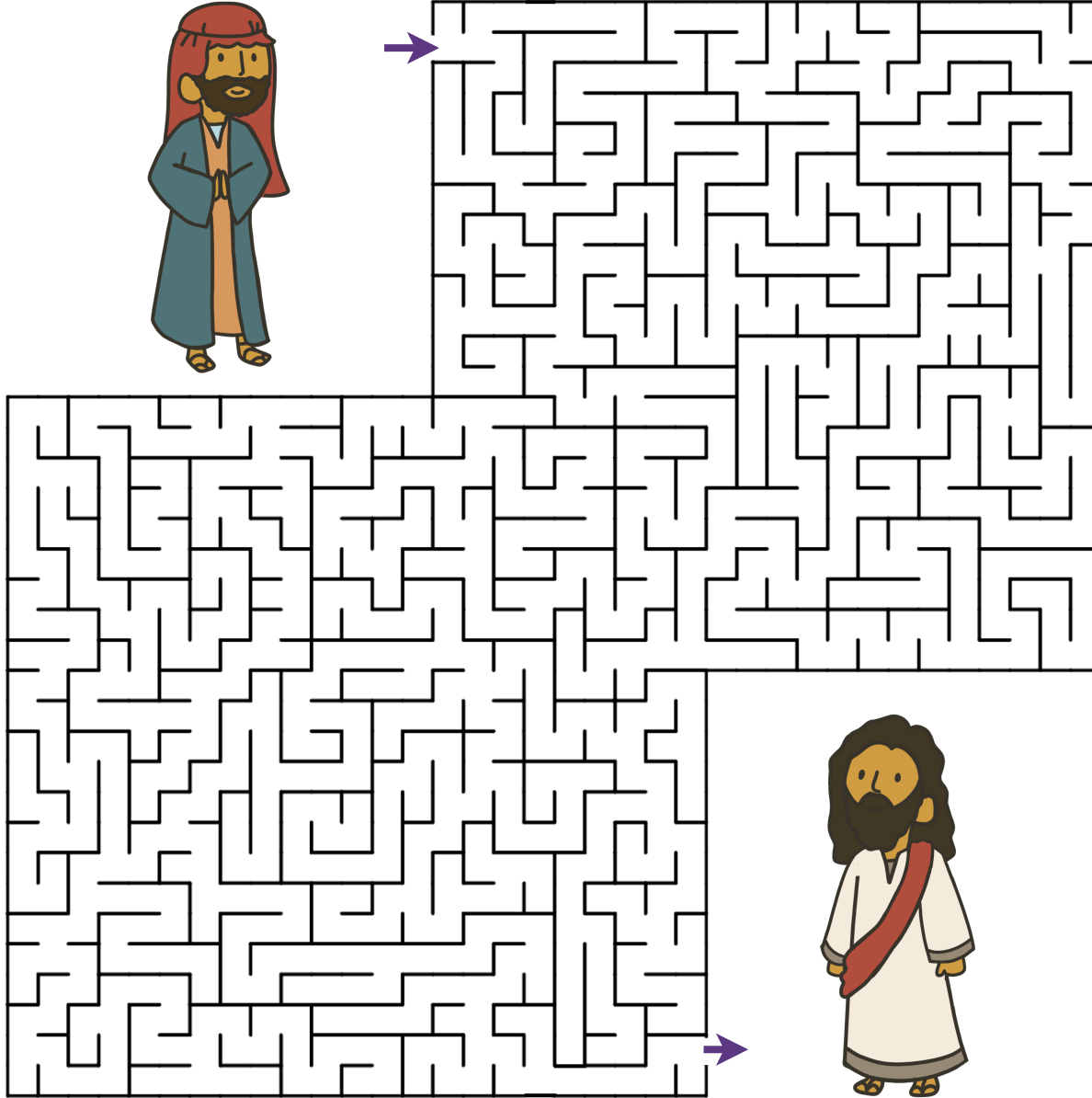
REMEMBER THIS
