I am packing for the AVA Global Women's Conference in Mijas, Spain. I will be leaving January 24 to meet with the other staff in making final preparations for the conference, January 26–February 3. Thanks so much to all of you who will uphold me and the conference in prayer. We really seek to minister in God's strength and grace and look to Him to work powerfully in women's lives. I will be providing counseling to four women each day, leading a discussion group, and have informal opportunities to minister around meals, breaks and social activities.

There are 119 women coming from 38 countries. They are single, married, moms, medical professionals, educators, church planters, counselors, and leaders. There is so much kingdom work happening in the name of Jesus through these women's ministries. They are coming to soak in God's Word, worship together freely, share together with like-minded women, and to receive sensitive care designed to meet each woman's needs through professional Christian counseling, spiritual direction, life coaching, consulting with a medical doctor, and time in the prayer room.

Please pray for:

- Nothing to hinder staff and participants from coming, safe travel, freedom from illnesses and accidents. Please pray especially for me to get over a persistent virus so I can arrive healthy and with energy to fulfill my roles fully.
- Each woman attending to feel welcomed and ministered to deeply.
- Wisdom and grace for me to effectively help the four women I'm counseling with whatever need or issue they wish to focus on.
