




Worship at Home

JANUARY 25, 2026



Use the following ideas to help your family spend some time worshipping God around Psalm 51. You'll also find some specific ways to pray for the partners we had planned to serve on Love Shelbyville day.

SCRIPTURE

Read Psalm 51 and make a list of everything David asks God to do in his prayer. Spend time talking about any verse that the Holy Spirit highlighted as you read together.

Read the backstory of this Psalm in 2 Samuel 12:1-15. Have a conversation about the blessings God has given you. Take time to praise God for those blessings.

SINGING

Find your favorite version of the song Jesus Paid it All and worship a long with it.

ACTIVITIES

If you have kids playing in the snow, emphasize verse 7 with them as you get them ready to go play or as they come in to warm up. Emphasize the beauty of the clean snow.

Start a confession jar in your home to remind one another of the need to confess sin to God. You can have people drop an object in it when they confess a sin. Write out verses 9-10 and put it on or near the jar as a prayer that can be prayed.

PRAYER

Crestview, Colonial Hall, Mercy Medical, other medical facilities, and institutions where shelter in place weekends will be happening - Pray that God would preserve their power sources, give endurance to their staff, and peace to their patients.

Pray that God would open doors for you to share the gospel with neighbors you might not usually interact with.

Pray for Stormhaven Youth Ranch as this storm will likely create many difficulties for the ranch. Pray also that God would send several devoted ladies to serve with kids this spring.

Pray for students and their families who are served by the Backpack Project that they would have the food and resources they need during the storm. Pray in general that God would give us eyes to see those around us who might need assistance.

Pray for road crews and first responders who are out working in the storm. Ask God to protect them and give them endurance.

Pray Psalm 51 over your own life, confessing to God any sin and asking him to renew in you a steadfast spirit.
