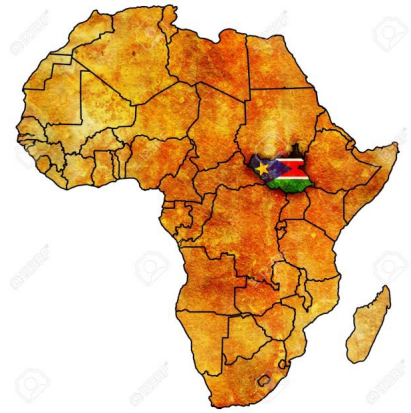


News Updates from Sandy

And so, after much prayer & advice I have made the decision to retire from SIM Canada/South Sudan at the end of June '26. SIM Canada will be helping me with all the steps to make this happen. I have been with SIM for 24 years. Hard to believe! In looking back, I feel very blessed in so many ways: meeting many lovely people, lessons learned in helping me to grow in my faith & walk with the Lord, as well as seeing how God has used me in His work & ministry of reaching those who had not heard of God's Good News, as well as strengthening His Church. What an adventure & a blessing to be a part of what God is doing. Thank you all for partnering with me in this amazing ministry. This has been YOUR ministry as well through your prayers & support. God's blessings to you.

In these next 6 months, my plans are to be involved in missions as much as possible through supporting churches, as well as traveling out to Alberta (when the weather is better) & visiting those who I have not yet seen.
