General Fund update

Year to date as of December 31, 2025:

Giving \$794,688

Budget \$804,605

Shortfall \$ (9,917)

These numbers excludes one-time estate gifts that were added to our reserve funds. Since our last update the deficit decreased significantly due to generous giving. The general funded ended in the black because of faithful giving, earned interest income, and management of expenses.
