[17] For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith Bk: by Jerry Bridges: Bookend.</p>	<p>[LIVING IN PERSONAL STRENGTH] CARNAL CHRISTIAN: - Definitely saved (Spiritual birth) (sometimes unbaptised) Matthew 13:13-17 AMP [13] This is the reason I speak to the crowds in parables: because while [having the power of] seeing they do not see, and while [having the power of] hearing they do not hear, nor do they understand and grasp [spiritual things]. [14] In them the prophecy of Isaiah is being fulfilled, which says, 'YOU WILL HEAR and KEEP ON HEARING, BUT NEVER UNDERSTAND; AND YOU WILL LOOK and KEEP ON LOOKING, BUT NEVER COMPREHEND; [15] FOR THIS NATION'S HEART HAS GROWN HARD, AND WITH THEIR EARS THEY HARDLY HEAR, AND THEY HAVE [tightly] CLOSED THEIR EYES, OTHERWISE THEY WOULD SEE WITH THEIR EYES, AND HEAR WITH THEIR EARS, AND UNDERSTAND WITH THEIR HEART, AND TURN [to Me] AND I WOULD HEAL THEM [spiritually].' [16] But blessed [spiritually aware, and favored by God] are your eyes, because they see; and your ears, because they hear. [17] I assure you and most solemnly say to you, many prophets and righteous men [who were honorable and in right standing with God] longed to see what you see, and did not see it, and to hear what you hear, and did not hear it. Behold, now is "THE ACCEPTABLE TIME," behold, now is "THE DAY OF SALVATION"— 1 John 1:5-9 TLB [5] This is the message God has given us to pass on to you: that God is Light and in him is no darkness at all. [6] So if we say we are his friends but go on living in spiritual darkness and sin, we are lying. [7] But if we are living in the light of God's presence, just as Christ does, then we have wonderful fellowship and joy with each other, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from every sin. [8] If we say that we have no sin, we are only fooling ourselves and refusing to accept the truth. [9] But if we confess our sins to him, he can be depended on to forgive us and to cleanse us from every wrong. And it is perfectly proper for God to do this for us because Christ died to wash away our sins.
