Communication Column

The Women's Prayer Focus Group (WPFG) began two years ago this month. The purpose of the prayer group is urgent and earnest kingdom-centered prayer for reawakening, renewal and repentance for Christians, the church, our country and the world. We launch our prayer time using the clear pattern for prayer we've been given in the Lord's Prayer (we pray that God's kingdom come and His will be done) and 2 Chronicles 7:14 (which indicates revival of our land is dependent upon the humbling, prayerfulness, seeking God's face and the repentance of Christians). We receive guidance from resources provided to us by the TBMB, the website onecry.com, and other valuable helps; but first and foremost, God's word and the Holy Spirit are fully sufficient to lead us into God-centered and kingdom-focused prayers. We depend on the Holy Spirit as our indwelling prayer tutor to lead us in prayer that is God-aligned, powerful enough to conform and transform us to Christ and ultimately lead to God's glory.

In October 2024, we studied Matthew 18:19 ("Where two or three are gathered...") and learned that the word "agree" is from the root word for "symphony," meaning to be of one mind, one purpose, to be in harmony. We thank Jesus for interceding for us, which He does, constantly, so that in our prayers we might align our wills with God's will.

In the context of reawakening, renewal and repentance, we also pray earnestly for the leaders of our church (Pastor Jon, Justin, Deacons, Sunday School teachers, VBS leaders), for families in our congregation, and for those who've gone out from our church in mission and ministry. We also pray diligently for those in authority over us in government.

WPFG will reconvene January 27th and continue through April 2026. All ladies are welcome to join us on Tuesday mornings from 9:30 AM to 10:15 AM.

Another 2026 prayer opportunity is to join with Tennessee Baptists for a year-long focus on revival using weekly Prayer Prompts provided by the Baptist & Reflector. Three prompts each week will enable us to all "agree together" as we pray for: 1) those without Christ; 2) for the church; and 3) for our pastors. Please see the bulletin each Sunday (or the Baptist & Reflector) for the weekly prompts, and let's add our congregation's prayers to all those across our state for God's kingdom purposes.
