**Big Idea:** The Great Commission isn't a special calling for a few — it's the everyday identity of every believer.

*"Go therefore and make disciples of all nations... teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always..."*  
(Matthew 28:19-20, ESV)

## WEEK 2 — Go: Living Sent in Everyday Life

Text: Matthew 28:19–20

### Icebreaker:

- When you hear the word “mission,” what comes to mind?
- Share a place you go every week that might actually be part of your mission field.

### Read the Passage: Matthew 28:19–20

### Discussion Questions:

#### 1. “Go” means “as you go.”

How does this interpretation change your understanding of the Great Commission?

#### 2. Your existing mission field

Where do you spend most of your time (work/home/gym/etc.)?  
How might God be calling you to see that space differently?

#### 3. Disciples, not converts

What is the difference between “winning someone to Christ” and “making a disciple”?  
Why does Jesus emphasize discipleship instead of decisions?

#### 4. Teaching to observe

How does someone learn by watching your life?  
What areas of your life demonstrate Christ well?  
Which areas need growth?

#### 5. Jesus’ promise of His presence

Where do you most need to remember that Jesus is with you?

### Personal Reflection:

What is one place in your weekly routine where you sense God saying, “**I have sent you here**”?

### Next Step Challenge:

Ask God each morning:  
**“Who are You sending me to today?”**  
Then act on whatever opportunities arise.

### Closing Question

Are you lingering in the huddle...  
or are you willing to step onto the field Jesus has already called you to play on?

### Closing Prayer Prompt:

“Jesus, open our eyes to see our daily lives as mission fields. Help us represent You with courage, humility, and love.”
