

## Why is Jesus God in the Flesh & the Son of God? January 25, 2026

**2 Corinthians 9:15**, *"Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift!"*

### Jesus is God

**Mark 14:61-64**, *"The high priest questioned Jesus, 'Are You the Christ, the Son of the Blessed One?' And Jesus said, 'I am; and you shall see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of power, and coming with the clouds of heaven.'" Tearing his clothes, the high priest said, "What further need do we have of witnesses? "You have heard the blasphemy; how does it seem to you?" And they all condemned Jesus to be deserving of death."*

**Daniel 7:13-14**, *"I kept looking in the night visions, and behold, with the clouds of heaven one like a Son of Man was coming, and He came up to the Ancient of Days and was presented before Him. And to Him was given dominion, glory and a kingdom, that all the peoples, nations and men of every language might serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion which will not pass away; and His kingdom is one which will not be destroyed."*

**John 10:30-33**, *"I and the Father are one." The Jews picked up stones again to stone Him. Jesus answered them, "I showed you many good works from the Father; for which of them are you stoning Me?" "For a good work we do not stone You, but for blasphemy; and because You, being a man, make Yourself out to be God."*

**John 5:17-18**, *"Jesus answered the Jews, 'My Father is working until now, and I Myself am working.'" For this reason the Jews were seeking all the more to kill Jesus, because He not only was breaking the Sabbath, but also was calling God His own Father, making Himself equal with God."*

**John 14:6-9**, *"I am the way, the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me. If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; from now on you know Him, and have seen Him." Philip said to Jesus, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is enough for us." Jesus said, "Have I been so long with you, and yet you have not come to know Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; how can you say, 'Show us the Father'?"*

**Matthew 5:27-28**, *"You have heard that it was said...but I say to you..."*

**Matthew 7:29**, “Jesus was teaching them as one having authority and not as their scribes (teachers of the law).”

**Luke 4:8**, “*You shall worship the Lord your God and serve Him only.*”

**Exodus 20:3**, “You shall have no other gods before Me.”

**Acts 10:25-26**, “When Peter entered, Cornelius met him, and fell at his feet and worshipped him (Peter). But Peter raised him up, saying, “Stand up; I too am just a man.”

**Revelation 19:10**, “Then I fell at his feet (this is the feet of an angel) to worship him. But he said to me, “Do not do that; I am a fellow servant of yours and your brethren who hold to the testimony of Jesus; worship God.”

**Matthew 14:33**, “Those who were in the boat worshiped Him, saying, “You are certainly God’s Son!”

**John 9:38**, “The man said, “Lord, I believe.” And he worshiped Jesus.”

**Matthew 28:9-10**, “Behold, Jesus met them (Mary and Mary) and greeted them. And they came up and took hold of Jesus’ feet and worshiped Him.” Then Jesus said to them, “*Do not be afraid; go and take word to My brethren to leave for Galilee, and there they will see Me.*”

**Hebrews 1:6**, “Let all the angels of God worship Him (Jesus).”

**Matthew 3:17**, “This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well-pleased.”

**Well-Pleased:** to take delight in, to take pleasure in, to approve, to think well of
