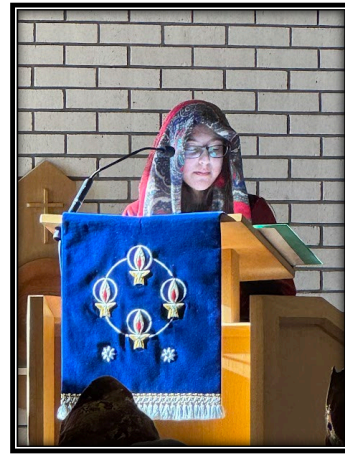
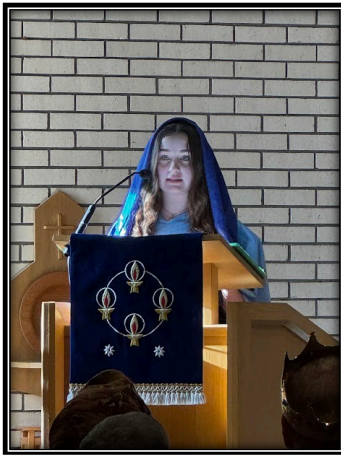
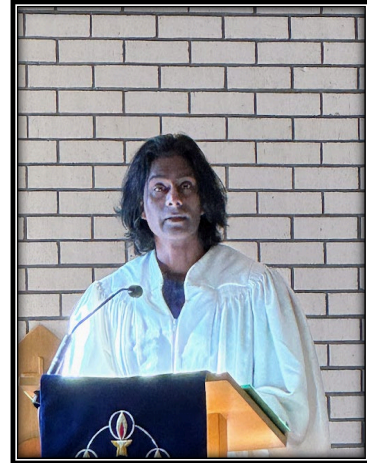
## FROM ST. ANDREW'S FOOD BANK
