Chef Chancy prepared an outstanding lunch, and Hawaiian Shaved Ice were a hit.

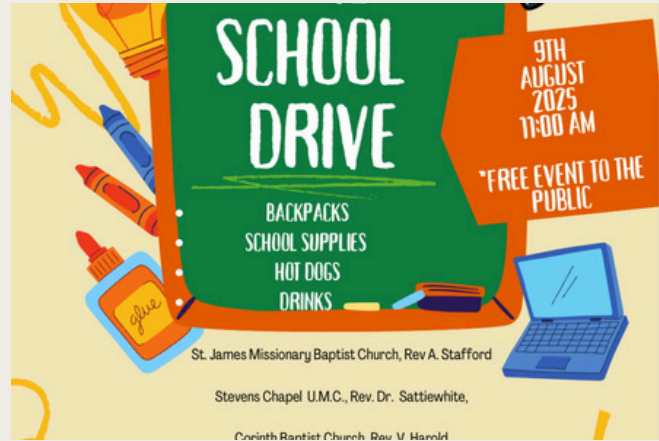
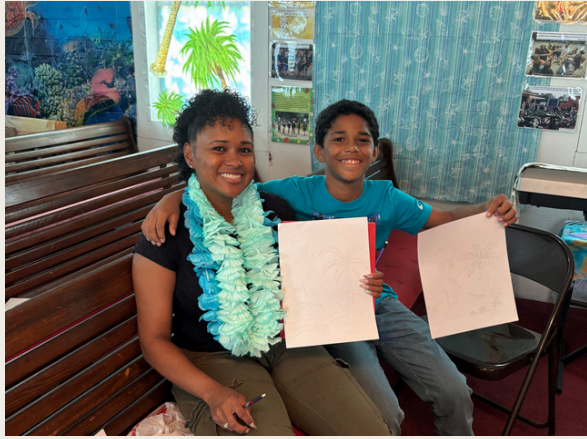
