

A MIND WORTH LIVING IN

Not only your mind is in you but you should also be aware that YOU LIVE IN YOUR MIND.

THE ATMOSPHERE OF YOUR MIND *determines what you experience every day*

- How you experience life the lens with which we interpret what's happening around us
- How we even interpret spiritual things
- How we see ourselves—How we see God
- How we interpret what's happening around us, our families, our circumstances

All that depends on the STATE AND CONDITION OF OUR MIND. The mind is important.

So, if your attitude is not so good then you are the first person to know about it. And if you have an INTERNAL DIALOGUE that doesn't agree with scripture or not with God's best for you then you're the one that is living with that on a day-to-day basis, oftentimes before anyone knows.

👉 So, **YOU SHOULD HAVE A MIND WORTH LIVING IN.**

We have been learning how to RECALIBRATE our MINDS—how to RENOVATE our MINDS by CHANGING THE WAY WE THINK. With the help of the Holy Spirit we want to be TRANSFORMED and CHANGED by the RENEWING OF OUR MIND so that we can know for sure what is the perfect and pleasing will of God.

Romans 12:2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

It's a peace in itself to know, "*I'm in the will of God. I know I'm doing the right thing. I'm at the right time at the right place. I'm in the will of God and no matter what's happened here, I know that it's going to turn around for good because I am walking with God.*"

We want that kind of peace. **YOUR MIND WILL ALWAYS BE AT PEACE WHEN IT STAYS ON GOD.**

Isaiah 26:3 You will keep him in perfect peace, Whose mind is stayed on You, Because he trusts in You.

The Psalmist says "you" to God but imagine God saying it to us. "*I will keep him in PERFECT PEACE. Whose mind is stayed on Me. Because He trust in Me.*

So, God is inviting us to let our MIND be fixed in, stationed on and secure in and established in God.

So we do know that OUR MIND WILL CHANGE when our MINDSETS CHANGE, if our INTERNAL DIALOGUE CHANGES. The silent dialogue that we silently have about ourselves, what we really think about ourselves. What we think about when we first hear scriptures. How do we filter things that we see and hear on a regular basis every day?

We talked about "*Out of the abundance of the heart, the mouth speaks.*" (Luke 6:45).

👉 So, often times our tongue is an indication of what we are thinking on the inside.

THE MIND OF CHRIST

Philippians 2:5 Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus.

*This is one of the most powerful texts we can read in the New Testament to help us to RECALIBRATE OUR THINKING and to RESET OUR MIND, to REALIGN OUR THINKING, to be able to deal with the seat of our EMOTIONS, to bring ALIGNMENT to any doctrine that we might have, Traditions of men. This is the one text that we're going to look at today that's going to help us RECALIBRATE OUR THINKING and help us RENEW OUR MIND. We need to be willing to say, "*I'm willing to change my MIND.*" We're going to experiencing a CHANGING and a RENOVATING and RENEWING of our MIND internally, but also externally. You're going to see a shift take place here this morning.*

👉 **LET THIS MIND BE IN YOU WHICH WAS ALSO IN CHRIST JESUS.**

Well, before I can have the kind of mind that Jesus demonstrated to us ,
I must find out what kind of MIND we're talking about.

Because he is saying, “*LET THE WORD*”, the concept in the Greek is *perceive, strive to, seek after, consider, look for, model, imitate*. Let the same exact MIND begin in you. *Agree with His mind, understand His mind, Perceive His mind*, and then **let this same mind be in you**. The exact MINDSET.—So for us to fully grasp this, *we need to look at Christ Jesus* and look **at His MIND**. so that we can **let that MIND be in us**. That’s what we are going after.

Philippians 2:5-8 MSG—*Think of yourselves the way Christ Jesus thought of himself. He had equal status with God but didn’t think so much of himself that he had to cling to the advantages {for privileges} of that status no matter what. Not at all. When the time came, he set aside the privileges of deity and took on the status of a slave, became human! ...*

So Jesus comes to earth and He becomes a man. And He is fashioned after man. So here He is. He **HUMBLES HIMSELF**, in other words, **though he’s God, but He SET ASIDE HIS PRIVILEGES AS GOD**. He didn’t cease to be God, but He set aside His privileges, His status, all that He is as God to become truly man. So He would be limited in a sense. It says, “*When the time came He set aside the privileges of deity and took on the status of a slave.*”

Some things we’re going to read in this text today, they’re going to shake your mind. That’s good. If your mind starts to be like, “*Whoa, I don’t know if I can process that. I don’t know if I can handle that*”. That’s very good. That means **THAT PART OF YOU NEEDS TO CHANGE**. That means **YOUR MIND NEEDS SOME RENOVATIONS** in that particular area.

Because we need to **SEE JESUS**  **This is GOD incarnate**, meaning **God taking on human body**. So God comes and He becomes a human being. He takes on a human body in Christ. That’s why Christ is incarnate. The SON OF GOD becomes man. This is the whole beauty.—How man know that’s already several layers of HUMILITY that we need to dig into?

...Having become human, he stayed human. It was an incredibly humbling process.
So the first thing we can learn about whatever this kind of mind is,

 **it must be a HUMBLE MIND.** Not a degrading mind, but a humble Mind.

 **HUMILITY** in the New Testament basically means **there is someone greater than us**.
 **HUMILITY** says **the lesser one RECEIVES from the greater one**.

But in Jesus’s case, He is also the GREATER ONE that becomes the LESSER ONE as He walks among us. So Paul is saying, “*He became a slave. He became human. And having become human He stayed human. It was an incredibly HUMBLING PROCESS.*

...He didn’t claim special privileges. Instead, he lived a selfless, obedient life and then died a selfless, obedient death—and the worst kind of death at that—a crucifixion.

He didn’t say “*I’m God*,” Any moment like remember when He said, “*I could call, you know, 12 legions of angels*.” He didn’t do it. When He was challenged before Pilate, He was quiet the whole time. Why? Because of this. **He didn’t claim special privileges. Instead, He lived a selfless, obedient life** and then died a selfless, obedient death. And the worst kind of death at that—a crucifixion. The Roman crucifixion was known around the world in history at that time is **the worst possible way a human being would be condemned to death**.

That is the means that this KING, this God, the SON of God would come and HUMBLE himself.

- Are you seeing the levels of HUMILITY Jesus is walking through?
- **What kind of MINDSET does He have to have to know HE’S GOD** who created the whole world and everything in it? *all creation to know all that He’s preeminent, He’s the first, He’s the last — to HUMBLE HIMSELF like this?*
- **What kind of MIND** does that have to be?

 **If we’re going to ever CHANGE AND RENEW OUR MIND and CHANGE THE WAY WE THINK,**

Why are we looking at His MIND? You’re going to find that..

 **UNDERSTANDING HIS MIND, we’re going to find healing for ours.**

That’s the point of looking..

This is why  it's **THE PLUMBLINE TO BRING ALIGNMENT to everything in your life. Yes, it is !!**

WE GOT TO START WITH HUMILITY. !

13:13

Philippians 2:9-11 MSG—Because of that obedience, God lifted him high and honored him far beyond anyone or anything, ever, so that all created beings in heaven and on earth—even those long ago dead and buried—will bow in worship before this Jesus Christ, and call out in praise that he is the Master of all, to the glorious honor of God the Father.

Why did Jesus do these things?

Mark 15: 22 And they brought Him to the place Golgotha, which is translated, Place of a Skull.

What kind of mind does that take to all of this on when you are the Son of God? A King of kings wearing a crown of thorns, the Lord of heavens armies, beaten and bruised though He is without sin.

He did this because of us. >> That will align your MIND with the mind of Christ.

Isaiah 53:5 But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.

Everything is Yes and Amen through the cross.

Christ is quiet all the time when they mocked Him and beat Him. And He and to carry His own cross. He emptied Himself from His Godhead privileges.

Mark 15:22 And they brought him to the place Golgotha, which is translated, place of a scull

There is something about calvary that aligns our MINDSETS.

Jesus became a curse to that we can experience the Blessing of God

We only become changed when we look through the lens of the cross.

Romans 6:14 For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace.

God is not judging me of my sin. It comes through the ...

HIS MINDSET—I'M TAKING THIS CURSE FOR THEM

We should not be tolerating the curse!

Your INNER DIALOGUE...

All we have to do is ACCEPT THIS MINDSETS

Why would our mind wrestle to accept that Jesus was humbled to this degree?

The CROSS is the one place where FREEDOM comes. We have to know the truth intimately.

Romans 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.

The depth of how deep we can...

The mindset God wants us to have—HE DID ALL THIS FOR YOU because GOD LOVES YOU.

Text

He became sin that you ...

More people have their mind tuned to the devil's channel than to God.

Colossians 2:8 TPT—Beware that no one distracts you or intimidates you in their attempt to lead you away from Christ's fullness by pretending to be full of wisdom when they're filled with endless arguments of human logic. For they operate with humanistic and clouded judgments based on the mindset of this world system, and not the anointed truths of the Anointed One.

Text

Colossians 2:9-10 TPT—For he is the complete fullness of deity living in human form. [10] And our own completeness is now found in him. We are completely filled with God as Christ's fullness overflows within us. He is the Head of every kingdom and authority in the universe!

We are complete when we are FOUND IN HIM. Something starts to change.

Daniel and his two friends in fiery furnace. They had a CHANGED MINDSET.

Something happens when the mind humbles himself to ...

The life of God will be flowing through you. Heaven is on the inside of you!

If you come to this place of Golgotha and your MIND gets aligned with that truth.

Colossians 2:11 TPT—Through our union with him we have experienced circumcision of heart. All of the guilt and power of sin has been cut away and is now extinct because of what Christ, the Anointed One, has accomplished for us.

A mindset without sin is worth living in.

You don't have to be...

Extinct means "it no longer exists."

Romans Consider yourself dead to si

Text

Colossians 2:12 TPT—For we've been buried with him into his death. Our "baptism into death" also means we were raised with him when we believed in God's resurrection power, the power that raised him from death's realm.

Text

Colossians 2:13 TPT—This "realm of death" describes our former state, for we were held in sin's grasp. But now, we've been resurrected out of that "realm of death" never to return, for we are forever alive and forgiven of all our sins!

What MIND is your mind FOCUSED ON?

Colossians 2:14 TPT—He canceled out every legal violation we had on our record and the old arrest warrant that stood to indict us. He erased it all—our sins, our stained soul—he deleted it all and they cannot be retrieved! Everything we once were in Adam has been placed onto his cross and nailed permanently there as a public display of cancellation.

Maybe you didn't have a revelation of the cross.

Your answer is always the cross. Always go to the cross.

The devil always goes around to get your mind aligned with him. And then your mind opposes God.

When the enemy comes to you - point to the cross!!!

Colossians 2:15 TPT—Then Jesus made a public spectacle of all the powers and principalities of darkness, stripping away from them every weapon and all their spiritual authority and power to accuse us. And by the power of the cross, Jesus led them around as prisoners in a procession of triumph. He was not their prisoner; they were his!
