


Hearing **GOD'S VOICE**



2. He speaks through his Holy Spirit.


(2 Corinthians 2:14 TLB)

- The Holy Spirit uses words.



While Peter was still thinking about the vision, the Spirit said to him, “Simon, three men are looking for you. ²⁰ So get up and go downstairs. Do not hesitate to go with them, for I have sent them.” (Acts 10:19)

- The Holy Spirit uses your conscience.



is safety. (Proverbs 11:14 NKJV)*


*Without good direction, people lose their way;

5. He speaks through prophetic words, dreams and visions.



In the last days, God says, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your young men will see visions, your old men will dream dreams. Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days, and they will prophesy. (Acts 2: 17-18)



6. He can speak through
circumstances.
