Missionaries In Mexico

Dear Carl Hewlett, Gary S. Moore, and the GPA Missionary Agency Committee,
Greetings from me and our congregation. May the grace and peace of our Lord Jesus Christ govern your ministries.

I would like to express my gratitude for allowing me to be part of the missionaries of the honorable GPA missionary agency. I want to share with you that by joining GPA, God answered a prayer that my wife and I had been praying for years, and now we can see it fulfilled and witness how God arranged everything for us to be part of your team.

I would also like to use this opportunity to share a little of what God has allowed us to do during the last three months of 2025, during which God manifested himself gloriously through our church and ministry.

In October, I had the opportunity to travel to Costa Rica, accepting the invitation from my brother Bismark Martínez, to preach at the Leaders' Retreat that the church in Canalete organizes annually. I was also able to participate in the Missions Conference of that church. It was a great blessing to meet the brothers and sisters in the church in Canalete, to get to know the region, and to see the great need for Christ that the people have in that beautiful country. I returned very challenged, since one of my prayers during this trip was that God would use us, but also that I would have an open heart to the needs of people without Christ.



During our trip to Costa Rica, I was able to meet the wonderful church in Coronado under the pastorship of my brother Alex Araya. We were able to share the Word and rejoice in getting to know the Araya family, whom I hold in my heart and prayers for the difficult process they went through in 2025 with the loss of Pastor Jorge Araya.



In November, here in our country, Mexico, we organized a Youth Evangelistic Campaign where we had 80 new young people listening to the gospel, and some of them were able to declare their faith in Jesus. It was a great joy, as our entire church participated in this activity, serving the young people, providing food, and offering other things to encourage them to come.



At the end of November, we traveled to the state of Florida to attend two missionary conferences. During this trip, I had the blessing of meeting Brother Carl Hewlett and his beloved wife Nancy, with whom we shared a very pleasant afternoon in the company of our Brother Bismark and his wife, Sister Iris Villalobos.

At the end of December, we had a very fruitful evangelistic Christmas service. We saw many brothers and sisters present with guests, and some of them have continued attending our church. We had a very edifying end to the year for the entire church.



Also, as I conclude, I would like to mention that this year we received a medical diagnosis regarding my wife's health. For the past two years, she has been battling a disease in her reproductive organs called endometriosis. This disease can generate cancerous tumors. The doctor has ordered some tests to rule out other complications and also to schedule surgery to remove the affected organ.

For this, we ask for your prayers, as the surgery is quite expensive in our country, equivalent to \$10,000 USD. We trust in God that He will provide the resources and well-being for my wife.

- Prayer for the remodeling project of the church building we are currently renting.
