A non-refundable fee of \$175 is due at the time of registration. This fee may be paid by cash, check, or Tuition Express (returning families only). Additional siblings in a family will be charged a discounted registration fee of \$150. This fee will *not* be applied to future tuition fees.

A one-time \$75 supply fee will be due in August 2026 to offset costs of snacks, classroom materials, and other needed supplies.






