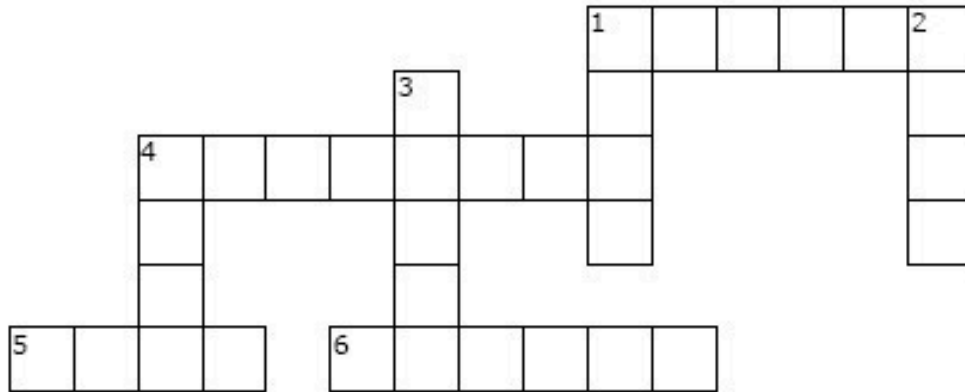

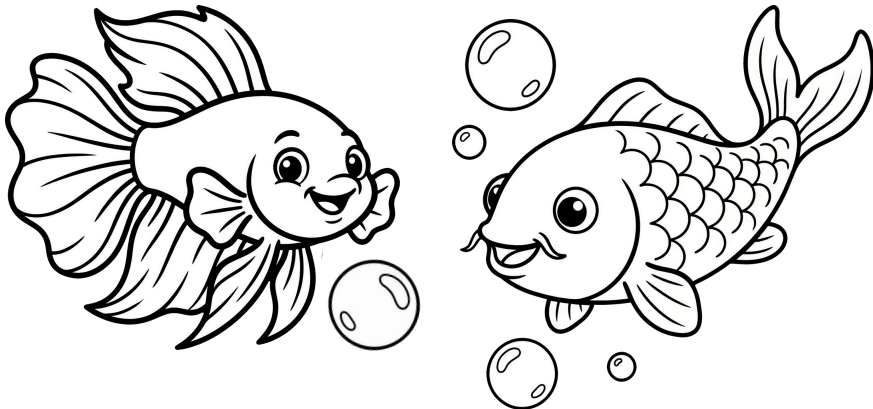
ACROSS

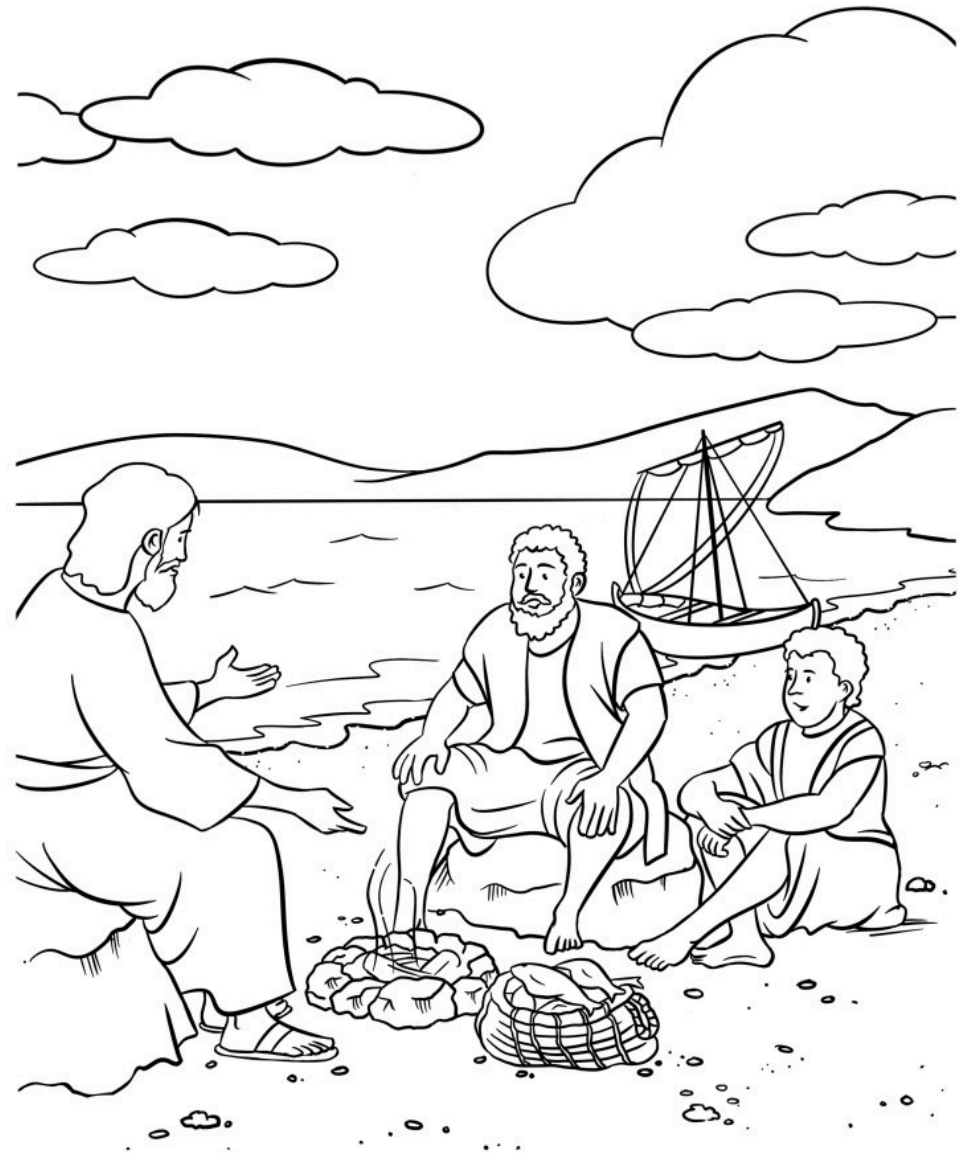
