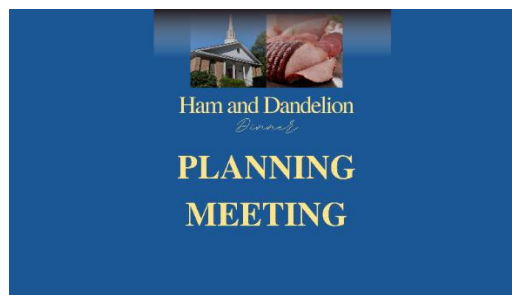


## Valentines for Our Church Friends

- A list of church members Pastor John will be visiting is at the church. There are ten people total if you would like to make something for everyone.

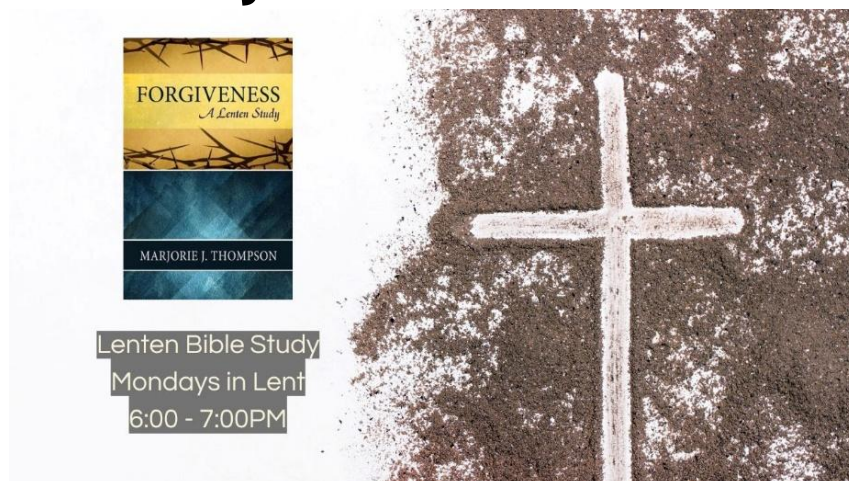
## Upcoming Church Meeting:
