August - December Ministry Update

Dear Beloved Ministry Partners,

Warm greetings to you in the precious name of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

We thank God for each one of you and for your faithful prayers and support. It is our joy to share with you how the Lord has been working in our church ministry from August to December 2025. Your partnership continues to strengthen and encourage us as we serve here in the Philippines.

On August 24, we held our 3rd Discipleship Awards, recognizing church members who completed the Bible course "Biblical Integrity." This discipleship course consists of 12 lessons with activities and is conducted every Sunday afternoon.





Classes are divided into six groups to allow closer teaching and fellowship. It was a joyful time as we celebrated spiritual growth and commitment to God's Word.

On the first Sunday of September, we began a new discipleship course entitled "Characteristics of the Wise." We are grateful to see our members continue to desire deeper biblical understanding and Christlike living.

On September 21, we celebrated Grandparents' Day at our church. We honored our grandparents with a simple gift to express our appreciation for their faithfulness and influence in their families. Later that month, during the last Sunday of September, we held a Ladies' Fellowship, where my wife shared a lesson on the life of Eve, encouraging the women to reflect on God's grace, purpose, and wisdom.

On October 5, we held a Teachers' Appreciation Program for our volunteer teachers. These faithful workers serve in our Good News Ministry, teaching children in more than 100 different areas. They do this joyfully and faithfully, even without financial support. We honored them with special gifts as a small expression of our deep gratitude for their sacrificial service.



On October 19, the ladies of the church surprised my wife, Sister Lita, with a special program in celebration of her 58th birthday. We were truly encouraged and humbled by their love and kindness.

On December 31, we experienced both sorrow and hope. One of our beloved sisters, a faithful church member for 30 years, passed away after a painful battle with cancer.
