

He Will Wake You Up

John 11:11

Lazarus has died and Jesus' mission is to wake him up, for he said that he was asleep. Sometimes we find ourselves in this same situation, not physically dead, but spiritually. Jesus has to wake us up, because we are asleep at the wheel, and he has to grab the wheel.

Lazarus was raised from the dead. Imagine his testimony. His sisters were mad at Jesus because Lazarus died and the disciples see the power of Jesus, for he has all power.

For us we should not overthink the what ifs, wheresofores, and howevers, but hold on to our ability to trust and believe in Him.
