

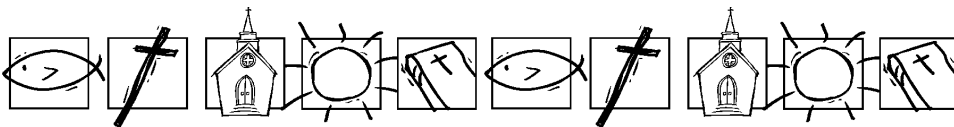

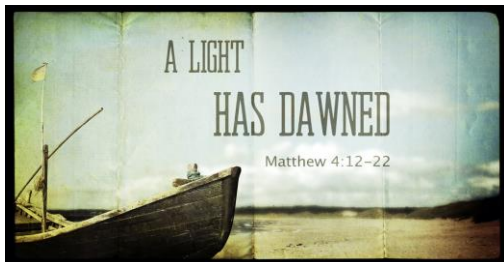
Pantry item: WV Pantry item for the month of January is toilet paper. Christ Open Market needs are cereal, canned fruit, canned meats, snacks and juice.

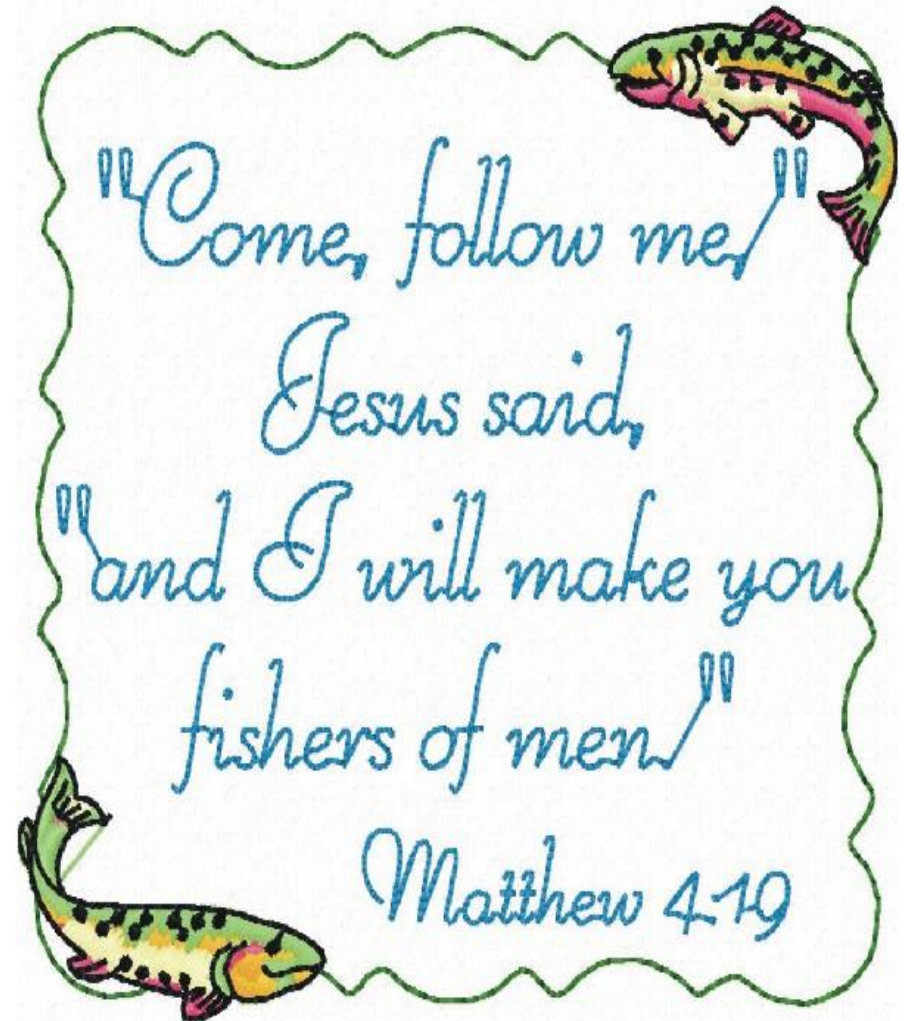
