Our plan is to visit the Daufuskie Island History Museum and First Union African Baptist Church to learn more about the remarkable culture that continues to thrive today. We will also worship at the church before we depart on Sunday. We will drive the bus but will then have to get on a ferry to get to Daufuskie. The only transportation on Daufuskie is by golf cart. We plan to stay at the condos on Daufuskie and rent golf carts for transportation. **Estimated cost: \$510 per couple.** Payment for the trip is due by Feb. 15th.
