

Thy Kingdom Come Thy Will Be Done . . .

January 15, 2026

Preamble for Today's Lesson

Matthew 7:24-25

So everyone who hears these words of Mine and acts upon them [obeying them] will be like a ^[a]sensible (prudent, practical, wise) man who built his house upon the rock.

And the rain fell and the floods came and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had been founded on the rock.

Today's Topic: "God's Inoculation for His Children"
(Financial Focus and Kingdom Expansion)

Psalm 34:10 (TPT)

Even the strong and wealthy grow weak and hungry, but those who passionately pursue the Lord will never lack any good thing.

Notice what Jesus is saying in Matthew 7:24-25:

. . . My Words
. . . Acting Upon Them
. . . Will Be a Prudent Man
. . . The Rain Fell, The Floods Came Against the House
. . . The House Did Not Fall, Because It was Founded on the Rock

Jesus is talking about the house that stood and the house that did not stand when the storm came. He did not say, "if the storm comes". He is inviting us to stand firm on His Word now. (So, what does that look like and how is that different for us today?)

And then notice, how the Psalmist says this is to be done?

Psalm 34, verse 10 talks about “passionately pursuing the Lord”.

Now, let’s look at the word “inoculation”

Inoculate *transitive verb*

- a: to introduce immunologically active material (such as an antibody or antigen) into especially in order to treat or prevent a disease
inoculate children against diphtheria
 - b: to introduce a microorganism into
inoculate mice with anthrax beans *inoculated* with nitrogen-fixing bacteria
 - c: to introduce (something, such as a microorganism) into a suitable situation for growth

There is an INOCULATED position of Defense, and an INOCULATED position of Offense, that I believe the Lord is calling us into, for such a time as this, based on changes that appear to be coming soon across the earth.

Both positions will require God’s Word ***into our life*** for us to function correctly as we were designed.

You see, without it, we may become subject to the world and the world’s system, and that is not the battleground we want to fight on. Once there, our tendency is to fight what the world throws at us with our own reason and strength . . . whatever seems logical at that time. If a fire starts in your house, you quickly move to extinguish the fire based on whatever is available to do that at that time. But, being fully inoculated in the Word, especially Psalm 91, could have kept that fire from starting in your home, in the first place!

When I pressed in on this topic with the Lord, I was directed to three Psalms: Psalm 20, Psalm 34, and Psalm 91. I understood those for me, to be the “Defense” foundation that I was to now construct. I believe that we are to all do this, asking the Lord to guide us all individually, in Scripture that will then become our own foundational word.

Still pressing in on this topic with the Lord, it soon became clear to me that there was an “Offensive” foundation that the Lord wants established in each of us . . . **and that was based on this Scripture:**

Psalm 24:7-10 (TPT)

So, wake up, you living gateways! Lift up your heads, you ageless doors of destiny! Welcome the King of Glory, for he is about to come through you. You ask, “Who is this Glory-King”? The Lord, armed and ready for battle, the Mighty One, invincible in every way! So wake up, you living gateways, and rejoice! Fling wide, you ageless doors of destiny! Here he comes; the King of Glory is ready to come in. You ask, “Who is this King of Glory?” He is the Lord of Victory, armed and ready for battle, the Mighty One, the invincible commander of heaven’s hosts! Yes, he is the King of Glory!

Now, I believe that great opportunity is coming to everyone actively looking for it, and at the same time, are led by the Lord . . . and are willing to do new things knowing that God Almighty is our source. This idea was very well captured on this Shawn Ryan Interview with Rob Luna (pardon the language, listen for the concepts explained):

We are called now to “re-posture” ourselves into that which the Lord is now leading and directing. Pastor Jack Hibbs also now speaks to this in his church service, attesting to the strength and power of God’s Word:

And if you don't know where to begin this journey – start by emptying your mind of your own inadequacies, found in everybody's self-talk, thus creating a new slate for the Lord to begin to write on.

Secondly, ask the Lord to reveal to you, very specifically, the new opportunities that He wants you to pursue for the expansion of His Kingdom.

Remember, God does not call the qualified, He qualifies the called – Mentally put yourself in that position as we start the new year.

And for me, some verses that spoke to me regarding my offensive foundation were found in Proverbs.

Here are couple of Scriptures that come to mind to me, for my own Offensive Foundation development:

Proverbs 22:29 (TPT)

If you are uniquely gifted in your work, you will rise and be promoted. You won't be held back - you will stand before kings

Proverbs 27: 25-27 (TPT)

Take care of your responsibilities and be diligent in your business and you will have more than enough – an abundance of food, clothing, and plenty for your household.

Now I believe there are more verses that Holy Spirit wants to show me, and have me understand, so as to further construct my own offensive foundation.

Yet, there still remains one more important ingredient . . . and this has a lot to do with us individually . . . and that needed ingredient is hard work in the thing that the Lord has called us to do now . . . big or small, it doesn't matter.

Colossians 3:23-24 (TPT)

Put your heart and soul into every activity you do, as though you are doing it for the Lord himself and not merely for others. For we know that we will receive a reward, an inheritance from the Lord, as we serve the Lord Yahweh, the Anointed One!

Proverbs 10:4 (TPT)

Slackers will know what it means to be poor, while the hard worker becomes wealthy.

Sometimes the enemy come in and tries to convince us to relax, to slow down, to take our foot off the gas pedal, , , especially when we are making a difference.

Now to summarize . . . the Lord is now inviting each of us, His Kids, to fortify our defensive and our offensive foundation, doing that now by immersing ourselves in the Truth of His Word.

The third ingredient is diligence, hard work in everything that the Holy Spirit is calling us into. We should never expect a final product to be produced by us, outside of our concerted effort . . . the example that comes to mind was Charlie Kirk, he diligently read 100 books a year enabling himself to stand up to an onslaught of public opinion with actual facts that could not then be repudiated.

I then saw this as a 3-Legged Stool not easily toppled. Don't view this as a formula to be followed, but more as the Truth employed in your life.
