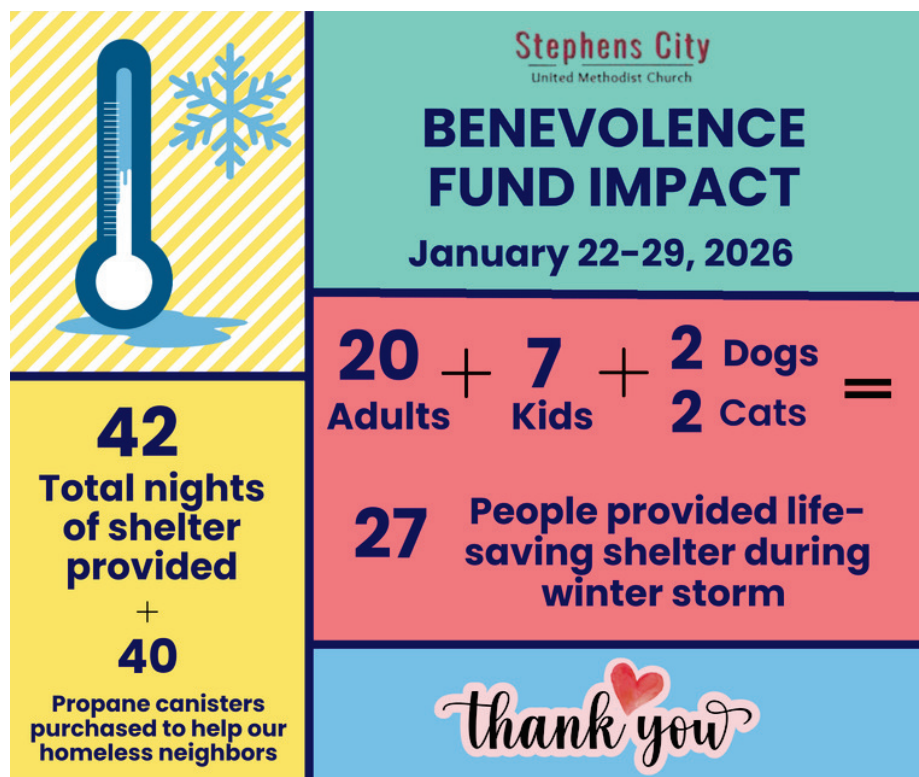


Missions Update:

The recent snowstorm and extreme cold kept our church busy responding to urgent needs in our community. Thanks to your generous support of the Benevolence Fund, we were able to step in in a big way — and may have helped save lives.

While local shelters expanded their capacity, gaps still remained that left many people without safe, warm places to stay. Through your generosity, we were able to provide 42 nights of shelter for 27 individuals, including families with children, people with pets who had been sleeping outside or in vehicles, and some of our most vulnerable neighbors — older adults, a pregnant woman, an amputee using a wheelchair, and a man on oxygen.
