SENIOR LUNCH - The seniors will meet at Dairy Queen.

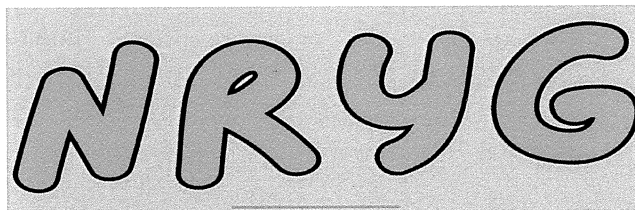
### NORTH RIDGE LADIES RETREAT

YOUTH OUTREACH - The elders request that if anyone is aware of a youth group age person who needs to be contacted or encouraged, please contact one of the elders or call the office.



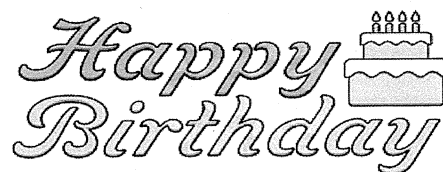
