What Should I Pray?  
Romans 8:26-27

Introduction:

I. <:26a> When I don't know the \_\_\_\_\_ of God I can count on the Spirit of God to help me \_\_\_\_\_.

1 Peter 3:7

It is the \_\_\_\_\_ of our human condition, so we don't \_\_\_\_\_ what we ought to pray for.

Thus, our inability to \_\_\_\_\_ God's will in some things is where we need some \_\_\_\_\_ help.

II. <:26b> The Spirit \_\_\_\_\_ on our behalf with \_\_\_\_\_ not uttered.
