The Board will gather responses in February and invite everyone to a gathering to review the responses. We hope to bring a summary to our congregational Annual Meeting on March 15. From this, we hope to articulate a renewed vision and outline a few key priorities for the future. The Board's role will be to gather your input and suggest next steps. The vision will come from and belong to the congregation.

Each small group in the congregation is asked to take 15-30 minutes during their usual meeting to respond to these questions. The ministers and Board members are happy to help facilitate, or the group can do their own facilitation. We will also invite everyone to join a short session after worship on Feb. 8 or Feb. 22 to share their responses.
