October – December 2025

We hope this Direct Line Ministry (DLM) update finds you all well.

We hope that you had a great Thanksgiving and a very Merry Christmas.

On October 4<sup>th</sup> we had our Christmas Joy Bag volunteer day at the DLM warehouse starting at 10:00 am in the morning. We had approximately 130 volunteers from various parts of the U.S. come and help with the final preparation of all the Joy Bags prior to shipping and we concluded with a meal and a great time of fellowship.

On the 11<sup>th</sup> of October we found ourselves travelling to Messina, New York for a Mission's Conference at Calvary Baptist Church. We had a great time of teaching, preaching, presenting the DLM ministry and fellowshipping over a great Sunday lunch at the church. They are a sweet group of people who love and serve the Lord.

Thanksgiving found us celebrating a delicious meal of turkey, ham and all the trimmings at Debbie's son's house. **Ephesians 5:20** Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ; We have so much to give thanks for; We are thankful for the Lord Jesus Christ and His amazing saving grace / thankful for the privilege of serving the Lord in missions / thankful for our health / thankful for souls being saved and baptized at our home church, thankful we still live in a free nation and thankful to be looking for that Blessed Hope return soon for His own. We take so much for granted until we've had a chance to visit other countries!

On December 5-12 we made a trip to the Dominican Republic to visit a church plant that I started in 2003 to celebrate their 22nd anniversary. We were able to take a suit case of Bibles and tracts to share with the brethren and had a great meal, preaching and fellowship with the members of that church encouraging them to go on for the Lord. We would ask your prayers for Iglesia Bautista Trinidad in Santo Domingo, Dom. Rep. After 22 years of leasing the church building the owners are now terminating the lease which will force them to find a new location.

During our visit we made a trip to a place in the mountains of the Dom. Rep. called Constanza. During that trip Debbie fell and fractured her left knee in three places. It was a very interesting trip back to the US but the Lord saw us through it all. Her surgery was December the 23<sup>rd</sup> and consisted of repairing the knee and placing a Titanium plate over the knee cap permanently. Please pray for her recovery which has been set at three to six months.

It is hard to believe we are winding down another year, but it is happening. DLM has been busy shipping containers this year 19 all together averaging 1.5 containers a month. DLM this year has shipped containers to El Salvador, England, Grenada, Guyana, New Zealand, Honduras, Nigeria, the Philippines, South Africa, and Togo. As of 2023 DLM has shipped over 5 million Scriptures around the world. What a blessing to be a part of this gospel ministry.

**Prayer Request:** We ask for your continued prayers and support for this very needful ministry. Having been a missionary myself I know the importance of that life line back to the States. With your support you not only supply the material needs of missionaries; Bibles, tracts and training material, but you also supply their personal needs.
