Falun Lutheran Church Annual Meeting Minutes

February 2, 2025

Quorum – Falun Lutheran Church – 15

Call to order: With a quorum present, Chuck Oleen called the meeting to order.

Opening prayer: Pastor Ben Fulton gave the opening prayer.

Minutes: Chuck Oleen, Chairman, asked the members whether they would like to have the minutes read or dispense with the reading of the February 4, 2024 annual meeting minutes. Erick Anderson made a motion to dispense with the reading of the minutes. Motion seconded and carried.

Pastoral Report: Pastor Ben reported that at the end of this coming July, he will have completed his sixth year as our parish pastor. He started in July 2019. Our parish is experiencing a lot of growth in members, baptisms and confirmed members and especially in our Sunday School. He said we have approximately 110 youth in our parish, which is wonderful, but we need everyone to help support this growth. 2024 has been a year of joy and sorrow. It's also been a difficult year in losing several of our very dear friends who had deep faith. With tragedy, comes unity. So many people have come together in some of our harder times in our parish, and that strengthens us as a community. We do mission work in helping Salina Food Bank, Dala Pantry, Salina Rescue Mission, Camp Tomah Shinga, Bethany College, Bethany Home, Riverview Estates and Sky Ranch. Our parish still does "KICK" with Bethany Lutheran and Messiah Lutheran Churches.

In 2024, we had three baptisms (Wyatt Dauer, Travis Oleen and Wells Sherwood); three confirmed (Blake Gengler, Riley Neywick and Josselyn Kindlesparger); and one death (Earl Dauer). Membership at the end of 2024, was 192 baptized and 143 confirmed after deducting one from the baptized and one from the confirmed due to Earl Dauer's death.

Election of Officers for 2025: Donna Dauer, Nominating Committee, presented the following ballot: Josh Dauer and Kyle Neywick are the nominees for church council. They will take the place of Chuck Oleen and Bernie Dauer who go off the council this year.

Since Josh Dauer is on the 2025 ballot for council member, they are replacing Josh (elected year 2023) with Dave Dauer to finish Josh's one year term remaining on the Auditing Committee. Dave's term will end in 2026. Donna Dauer will complete Nathan Carlson's term (year elected 2024) on the Auditing Committee, since Donna audited the 2024 books instead of Nathan Carlson. Nathan Carlson will serve as a new member of the Auditing Committee (year elected 2025). Bernie Dauer will serve one year on the Nominating Committee (year elected 2025). Keith Johnson moved to accept the nominations. It was seconded and passed.

Auditing Committee: Josh Dauer reported that the books had been audited and everything was correct.

Financial Secretary Report: Bernie Dauer gave the report. Total 2024 deposits were \$91,444.39. We had a Parish refund of \$13,353.80 for 2022 & 2023 for our share of money that was corrected out of the parish account. See complete report on page 16.

Memorial Fund Report: Norman Dauer gave the report. Ending 2024 balance was \$22,016.87. See complete report on page 17.

Parish Budget: Chuck Oleen presented the Falun-Salemsborg Parish Budget for 2025. Total budget is \$134,945.63.

Falun's contribution total for 2025 is 28.74% for \$38,783.38 with a monthly payment of \$3,231.95, which is \$293.20 more each month paid to Salemsborg compared to 2024.

Parish Budget (continued): Chuck Oleen reported that Pastor Ben would receive a 3% raise. Under the Parish Secretary line item, it was determined that Donna Swanson was underpaid. The 2024 expense for the Secretary Salary included Donna Swanson and Melanie Rishel since Melanie was working with the parish app and working on digitizing the parish records. The Parish budget for the Secretary Salary was set at \$12,000 for 2025. Salemsborg may budget more for Melanie's salary since they have more members. There was lengthy discussion regarding the app. Some felt it was not used as much by Falun members. After further discussion, Chuck announced we would vote by ballot, "yes" for passing the 2025 Parish Budget or "no" for not passing the Parish Budget. Chuck asked for two tellers to count the votes. Josh Dauer and Erick Anderson volunteered to be the tellers. Josh reported the 2025 Parish Budget passed by a unanimous vote of 27.

Treasurer's Report: Shirley Bloomquist gave the report. Beginning General Fund balance on 1-1-24 was \$52,822.97 and ending balance on 12-31-24 was \$75,041.86. The \$50,000 that was put into a 15 month CD @5.09% in 2023 at the Farmers State Bank was now a total of \$52,554.39 at the end of 12-31-24. It was decided at the January 14, 2025 Council Meeting to roll it over on 2-2-25 for another 15 months at 3.80% interest. Total 2024 deposits \$91,444.39 less total expenses \$69,225.50 minus In & Out Mission of \$2,014.55= +\$8,865.09. Complete report found on pages 20-22. Mission Investment Fund complete report found on page 25. Building Fund has a 1-1-25 balance of \$43,528.15. Complete report found on page 23. Special account (goes towards missions) has a 1-1-25 balance of \$12,242.10. Complete report on page 24.

Proposed 2025 Falun Lutheran Church Budget: Shirley Bloomquist presented the proposed 2025 Falun Lutheran Church budget. The proposed 2025 budget is \$73,588.89. See complete budget on pages 27-28. Chuck announced we would vote by ballot, "yes" for passing the 2025 Falun Lutheran Church budget or "no" for not passing the budget. Josh Dauer and Erick Anderson were tellers for the vote. Josh reported the 2025 Falun Lutheran Church Budget passed by a unanimous vote of 27.

Old Business: There was continued discussion regarding the Parish app.

New Business: Chuck Oleen asked if anyone was interested in attending as delegates to the ELCA Synod Convention in Kansas City in June. No one volunteered. Chuck stated that Clair and Jerrine Oleen would be interested in attending as delegates. They were unable to attend the annual meeting. It was the consensus for Clair and Jerrine to attend the Synod Convention in June.

Resolutions: Complete list found on page 29.

Adjourn: It was moved, seconded and carried that we adjourn the meeting at 10:25 a.m.

A soup luncheon followed the annual meeting.

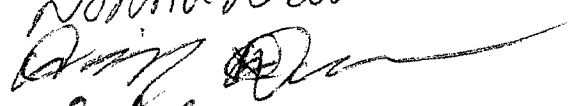

Our monthly share of the Parish Budget for 2025 has been \$3231.95 which was 28.74% of the parish budget. The monthly share for 2026 will be \$3107.50 which is 26.95% of the parish budget. The difference will be \$124.45 LESS each month this year.

2025 Falun Lutheran Church Sunday School Report

We are blessed to continue to have an active Sunday School program with about 23 kids in Pre-K thru 8th Grade. Material is lectionary based through Sparkhouse and Augsburg. Teachers for the Fall 2025-Spring 2026 season are:

Pre K-Kindergarten: Gwen Oleen & Leah Oleen

Grades 1-3: (rotating volunteer basis) Britta Dauer, Jenny Kindlesparger, Hayley Sherwood, and any other volunteers

Grades 4-5: Kristi Kern

Confirmation (Grades 6-8): Jerrine Oleen and Jim Smith

The Junior High Youth Group meets on the 2nd and 4th Wednesdays of the month at the Fellowship Center where Pastor Ben does a deeper dive into Confirmation topics during the 4th Wednesday meetings. Curriculum is a three-year rotation entitled "Here We Stand", also through Sparkhouse. Confirmands are encouraged to attend both the Sunday School and Wednesday sessions.

There were five 9th grade students from our Parish who were confirmed on Reformation Sunday, October 26, 2025. Those confirmed were Libby Blanner and Brogan Gengler from Falun; and Ridge Johnson, Wyatt Griffin and Mason Riedel from Salemsborg.

Starting Sept. 2025, our Sunday School offering is being collected into various wooden letter banks. Once each of the letters are all filled and rearranged, they will spell out a secret word. The kids are having fun making guesses as we add new letters.

Mandy Francisco created and directed the Christmas Program on December 14, 2025. Job Title: Youth Coordinator

Overview: To serve the mission of Jesus Christ in and through the Falun Salemsborg Lutheran Parish and in the community by leading the coordination of youth education and events. This role will focus on scheduling youth events, maintaining a healthy network of teachers, and supporting pastor and our volunteers to ensure we are planting seeds of faith that will grow to bear fruit in the youth of our parish and community.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities:

- Work with Pastor and learning ministry to plan and implement a variety of programs.
- Empower others to take part in the ministry of the church youth.
- Sunday School
 - Aid Sunday School Superintendent in curriculum implementation, parent communication, finding teachers, and any other tasks necessary.
 - Act as the point of contact for Parish Treasurer's to ensure finances are in place for Sunday School supplies.
 - Assist with VBS: Coordinate and empower others to plan and execute VBS for the parish.
- Middle School Youth Group -
 - Assist leaders in planning, preparing, and executing any events. Can act as head sponsor when needed.
 - Aid in getting parents timely and accurate information on all meetings, projects, and events.
 - Enrollment in Camp Tomah Shinga, Quake, or other gatherings and retreats.
 - Assist Pastor in organizing, preparing, and executing Confirmation.
- High School Youth Group
 - Assist leaders in planning, preparing, and executing any events. Can act as head sponsor when needed.
 - Aid in getting parents timely and accurate information on all meetings, projects, and events.
 - Enrollment in Camp Tomah Shinga and other gatherings or retreats.
- Act as Liaison for all Youth related activities in the parish and other area churches.

Terms of Employment and Benefits:

- Salary: paid monthly
- Part time employment: 10-15 Hours per week

Youth Coordinator Report

1. Prior to the coordinator position being approved, Abby and Pastor Ben organized a Youth-Led service for Palm Sunday, April 13th at both churches. Students signed up for “jobs” during worship that would best suit their talents. Students served and attended both services, Falun and Salemsborg. All feedback on this service has been positive with excitement for more youth-involved services in the future.
2. Youth Coordinator position was approved on April 14th, and we haven’t slowed down since.
3. The Easter Egg hunt was a success on Sunday, April 20th despite the rain. We had plenty of help hiding eggs from the MS/HS Youth groups and nearly 60 youth in attendance for church and the egg hunt. Thank you for all your help stuffing and donating eggs.
4. Saturday, May 3rd, Jared Nichols and Abby teamed up for a Karaoke Night held in the fellowship center. Attendance was low (6), but there is potential for a stronger turnout with more planning and advertising. We look forward to trying again in the future.
5. Senior Sunday was Sunday May 11th. Graduating high school seniors were invited to celebrate at the church of their choice. \$227.94 for three full-size sheet cakes (2 for Salemsborg, 1 for Falun), and we charged it to the Salemsborg charge account at White’s Foodliner in Lindsborg. Parents of the 9 seniors split the cost of the cakes. Abby has presented Jennifer with the complete cost for the cakes.
6. First Fundraiser for the YC salary was a Parish Garage sale on June 6 and 7th. Rummage Sale for the Youth Coordinator Position was a success! Youth Group members provided baked goods and sold items at a bake sale. Congregational members, with Molly Johnson at the helm, ran the Rummage sale. \$3000 was raised from the Rummage sale, and over \$300 from the bake sale.
7. August 10th from 5-7pm was the annual High School Youth Group Cookout and Swim party at Lakeside Park in Assaria. We had a very small group (4 students) attend. Small but mighty. Several other high school events were scheduled for the same date. Next year we will consider doing this earlier to avoid back to school events.

8. Blessing of the Backpacks took place at both Congregations on Sunday August 10th. All students (grade school through college) and teachers were encouraged to bring their backpacks for a blessing for the back-to-school season. We had a great turnout!
9. SS registration began Sunday August 10th. We had 39 families across the parish register and 27 for Salemsborg alone. 71 kids total, 51 for Salemsborg. Abby has been helping Gwen and Kelsey prepare class lists, organize parent helpers, and begin recruiting substitute teachers. This registration has been instrumental in the success of our youth leaders this fall.
10. Summer Senior High Trip - Due to a lack of response from the High School youth, there was no summer trip. Pastor Ben and Abby are planning to begin conversations and create commitment deadlines for next year's trip in January.
11. The July Parish Swim party and Ice Cream social was very well attended by both children and adults. Ice Cream Social raised \$107 for the Youth Coordinator Position.
12. The new Falun / Salemsborg Youth Groups social media account has been activated. This will be used to share current events, what the kids are doing, and share their experiences with the congregation. Please follow us on Facebook and Instagram. Abby is the admin on the page.
13. August 10th from 5-7pm is the annual High School Youth Group Cookout and Swim party at Lakeside Park in Assaria. If you have a high school youth group member in your family, please encourage them to attend.
14. Confirmation occurred on Sunday October 26th. Pastor Ben had his final meeting with the confirmands on October 11th where they discussed the service and their faith statements. Abby ordered cake for both services. Attendance was great at both churches.
15. T-Shirt Sales \$2470. We want all students to have a shirt. Please consider purchasing your shirt if you haven't already, and there are sponsorships for those who need support in purchasing. Thank you to everyone who has purchased or sponsored a shirt.

16. While the weather cut the Haunted Forest a day short, the chili feed and concessions stand went well. The Middle School was still able to raise a total of \$4059
17. The Highschool Youth Group hosted Smoky Valley's fifth quarter on Friday October 3rd. Thank you to the parents and congregational members who donated supplies for the event. Over 100 smoky valley students attended alongside 20 of our own Highschool youth group members.
18. Middle school youth group is gearing up for the Youth Quake event on February 6-8th. We have 22 kids and 5 sponsors attending this event in Wichita Kansas.
19. Both Falun and Salemsborg put on successful Children's Christmas programs. Falun's program had over 20 students PreK-12 participate. Salemsborg served Breakfast in Bethlehem and collected a free will donation to go back to the Youth Coordinator Position. Thank you, Molly and Mandy, for all your work!
20. The Highschool Youth Group had their annual Christmas Party on December 28th. We had 8 students in attendance. Food was served, gingerbread houses were made, and a great white elephant exchange was had.
21. The Middle School youth group had their Annual LOCK-IN on January 3rd. There were 22 students in attendance.

Middle School Youth Group Notes

- The Middle School youth group is going well. We have 27 students as a part of the MS youth and confirmation group. This includes a group of 10 8th graders to be confirmed next fall.

High School Youth Group Notes

- Abby has been the volunteer leader for the Highschool while we are still searching for a more permanent sponsor. The HSYG is a small but consistent group of about 10 students across grades 9-12.

The Committee appreciates all who volunteer to be lay readers, including confirmands who have done a wonderful job in this part of the services. In addition we appreciate those who give their time to usher church services and other special services. We appreciate the youth leaders in helping arrange acolytes for the services. The time that volunteers give is very important to the smooth efficiency of all services.

We give a special thank you also, to Nita Kay Carlson for directing choir and bells, including the Ding-a-lings; to Phil Kampfe for playing the organ and helping to choose hymns; and to Becky Pihl as our choir accompanist. We are appreciative of all of the hours of preparation, practice and performing that they provide the church and community.

T.A.C.O.L.
The Associated Churches of Lindsborg and surrounding areas

T.A.C.O.L. is comprised of Bethany Lutheran, Messiah Lutheran, St. Bridget's Catholic, Evangelical Covenant, First Baptist, Freemount Lutheran, Falun/Salemsborg Lutheran, Trinity Methodist, Bethany College, and Bethany Home.

T.A.C.O.L.'s main source of income is the thrift store which is open Wednesday through Saturday. In 2025 it was staffed by 2 full time managers, which are paid positions. Financial statements in the last quarter of 2025 showed record high sales. Nearly all profits in 2025, after expenses, were gifted to those in need in our community. Budgeted and supported ministries for 2025 were Weekday Church School, Child Care Assistance, Community Blessing Box, Dala Pantry, and Christmas Baskets.

Other gifts, by request, went to pay for summer recreation programs in Lindsborg and Marquette, blood drives, Baccalaureate expenses, annual prayer breakfast, summer adult meals, and Life Skills 101 program with the Lindsborg school. Each month, T.A.C.O.L. also gifted individuals and families in need who applied for assistance through the T.A.C.O.L. Financial Assistance office at the Covenant Church. Assistance included food vouchers, utility bills and/or rent payments, gas cards, motel vouchers, and medical bill assistance.

2025 accomplishments: Paid building loan ahead of schedule, replaced air conditioning unit, replaced concrete slab at the west entry and started digital media.

The 2025 president of the board is Pastor Chris Deines and VP is Pastor Jeff Waugh. Linda Ball is secretary, and Shirley Reissig is treasurer. All of these positions are up for election in 2027 and any board member is eligible.

2026 Goals: Refine mission statement, handbook, by-laws, website, volunteer recruitment and training. 2026 president is Pastor Jeff Waugh; VP is Pastor Chris Deines.

Special thanks to Susan Hemphill for her years of representing Salemsborg on the TACOL board and her volunteer work in the thrift store.

Our Falun, TACOL representative is Janice Morris who is also in charge of the voucher program, working Monday, Wednesday and Fridays from 1:00 to 3:00.

Our Salemsborg TACOL representative is Debbie Johnson and she provides voucher assistance on Wednesday evenings from 6:00 to 8:00.

BH treasury money has been used to help fund the Halloween candy for residents to hand out to Halloween trick or treaters, food warmer for the kitchen, décor items, tableware for the activities room, Music & Memory program, four outdoor park benches, large print bingo cards for BH & Sunflower Terrace Assisted Living, staff appreciation treats, and various other items.

BH Activities that our church representatives are assigned or volunteer for are:

- 1) 15 dozen cookies the first Wednesdays of the month to serve with coffee following Chapel each week.
They freeze the cookies and use them throughout the month.
- 2) Bingo at Bethany Home the 4th Mondays (except in December) at 2:00 p.m. Provide 50-60 prizes and 3-4 helpers suggested.
- 3) Bingo at Sunflower Terrace Assisted Living the 1st & 3rd Tuesdays at 1:30 p.m. Provide prizes for 15-20 residents and 2 helpers suggested.
- 4) Birthday Cakes at Bethany Home on the 3rd Fridays (except in December) at 2:00 p.m. We furnish two different flavored cakes and the Home furnishes the ice cream and tableware and 2 helpers suggested.
- 5) Happy Cart at Bethany Home on the 1st Fridays at 9:30 a.m. We go to each resident's rooms and offer them a treat from the cart. We provide the treats. This gives the residents some additional socialization. Since we have 12 churches involved, we only do this once a year. Four helpers suggested, two per cart.

A majority of the churches no longer have women's groups to fulfill some of the monetary donations, so we rely on our local congregations to help donate. Individuals from our churches have been good in helping donate money to be given to the activities staff to buy the residents nice Christmas gifts specific to their needs. We appreciate your generous support. If you ever have some extra time to help Debbie Johnson or Gwen Oleen with any of the above activities throughout the year, please let us know. We'd love your help. The residents enjoy our visits and activities. Let us know if you have any questions.
