## Gospel Faith (Galatians) Series Break-up

**Marketing Title of Series:** Galatians – the Fight for the Real Gospel

**Overview of the Series:** Paul's letter to the Galatians is a rescue mission. A church once formed by the sheer grace of Christ is drifting back toward rule-keeping, people-pleasing, and spiritual performance. Into that confusion, Paul writes with urgency and clarity: there is only one gospel, and it is a gospel of grace, promise, and Spirit-given freedom.

Across this series, we follow Paul as he defends the non-negotiable gospel, reminding us that salvation is God's gift—not our achievement. We see that the gospel carries God's authority, not human approval, and that true Christian living flows from being united with Christ, not from rebuilding the old scaffolding of law-reliance. Through Abraham's story, Paul shows that God's people have always been shaped by promise, not performance, and that in Christ we are no longer slaves but beloved sons and heirs.

As the letter crescendos, Paul calls us to stand firm in the freedom Christ has won, to walk by the Spirit who empowers real transformation, and to boast only in the cross—the centre of our identity and the source of our life.


This series invites God's people at LMAP to return to the simplicity and power of the gospel: to rest in Christ's finished work, to reject every counterfeit that adds to or subtracts from grace, and to live as Spirit-filled children who reflect the freedom, confidence, and joy of belonging to Jesus.

**Purpose of the Series:** To anchor God's people at LMAP in the one true gospel of grace—calling them to reject a reliance on the law or tradition or culture and instead stand firm in their Spirit-given freedom and identity as God's children, and live confidently under Christ's authority, boasting only in His cross.

### The Purpose of this Document:
