Part 1: Engage

- Read Acts 4:32–37.
- In your initial reading, what stands out to you? Key themes, words, phrases, people?
- What questions do you have about the text?

Part 2: Observation Questions

Why was it important for Luke to reset the story He is telling?

- In this text, Luke is pulling back the curtains to help us see clearly who these believers were becoming, as they testified and were being changed by Resurrected Jesus.

Ask Questions:

- **Who?** In what way is this passage all about Jesus?
- **Where?** What was happening in Jerusalem and in the area, as the Resurrected Jesus was resurrecting a Church?
- **How?** How counter-cultural were the actions of this community?
- **What?** What was motivating this community to be so caring and generous with one another?
- **Why?** Why would God choose to use a community of this kind to build His Kingdom?

- What is your key takeaway from this passage?
- Anything that you feel is important for you to understand or believe?
- Anything that God wants you to desire or do in response to this passage?
