



## Quiet Time Questions from 12/28/25

Start your quiet time each day with prayer. Ask the LORD to help you focus and understand what you are studying.

**MAIN POINT OF THIS WEEK'S PASSAGE:** Gospel ministry, gospel living can be hard, but the Lord provides us encouragement through His word and promises a crown of righteousness to all who keep the faith and long for His appearing.

**MEMORY VERSE FOR THE WEEK:** *But as for you, always be sober-minded, endure suffering, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry. (2 Timothy 4:5)*

1. **Be Sober, Be Ready**

Read 2 Timothy 4:1-8. How might you prepare yourself to have clear thinking (to be sober) regarding what the world may say about the gospel so that you can respond in a good and right manner, *with great patience and instruction*?

2. **True Gospel Living Is Hard**

Read 2 Timothy 4:1-8. Who might you be able to encourage this next year as they live out the gospel in their daily lives? Make a list and pray for them on a regular basis.

3. **Finish Well as an Example for the Reward is Worth It**

Read 2 Timothy 4:1-8. Paul told Timothy with confidence that he fought the good fight, that he finished the course, that he kept the faith, and that a crown of righteousness was laid up for him, could you say that about your Christian life? If not, what stops you?
