Where is AGAPE located?

New Hope Church

When does the co-op meet?

Tuesdays from 9:30 AM – 12:30 PM, with optional lunch and social time to follow.

What grades do you serve?

PreK through 12th grade

Do you offer childcare for younger siblings?

Yes! We offer a nursery for children younger than PreK at no cost for participating families.

How much does it cost?

\$40 per child, per semester.
Scholarships are available for families needing financial assistance.

How many classes are offered?

There are 3 class periods each co-op day.
Students will choose academic and/or enrichment classes once sign-ups are posted.

Is this a drop-off program?

No. Parents are required to stay on campus during co-op hours.

How do parents participate?

Parents may:

- Teach a class
- Assist in a classroom
- Help with setup or cleanup
- Spend time in our parent lounge

Who teaches the classes?

AGAPE is a parent-led co-op.

Parents, grandparents, and family members may teach or assist.

No degree required—just a heart for teaching.

Are clearances required?

Yes. All adults must submit child clearances.

They are free, and links will be provided at sign-ups.

Are students required to attend every class period?

No. Students may attend one, two, or all three class periods. We understand that some families may have prior arrangements and may not be able to arrive until later in the morning.

Are classes grouped by age or grade?

Classes are grouped by grade level. We recognize that each child develops at their own pace and may be working at different grade levels depending on the subject. For consistency in planning, families should select the grade level their child is enrolled in at home when registering for classes.

Does filling out the interest form commit us?

No. The interest form does not commit you to joining.
