FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

In 2017, 400 musicians gathered for an extraordinary performance titled Symphony for a Broken Orchestra. The musicians ranged from children to seniors and included amateurs, professionals, and even members of a world-class orchestra. What made the concert remarkable was this: every instrument was broken. Trumpets were taped together. Violins were missing strings. Bows were worn thin. Cellos barely held their shape while playing.

These instruments had come from public school music programs that lost funding. Music teachers saved the broken instruments, hoping they might someday be repaired. Instead, the composer chose to use them exactly as they were, and invited musicians to see what kind of music broken things could still make.

At first, many instruments were silent. Slowly, sound emerged in unexpected ways: tapping keys, scraping wood, turning pegs. Some players could only manage short bursts of sound. Others struggled to stay together. Yet over time, the fragments formed harmony. What emerged was not chaos, but music that was playful, rich, and alive. The performance ended with the thin, fragile squeal of a broken clarinet, and it was enough.

Ash Wednesday reminds us that the church looks much like that orchestra. We come marked by ashes; shaped by wounds, regrets, exhaustion, and fear. On our own, what we offer may feel off-key or incomplete. But gathered together under the direction of the Master Composer, God takes our brokenness and forms something beautiful. This is our hope as Lent begins: the God who exchanges beauty for ashes.

Isaiah 61:3 NKJV

"...console those who mourn in Zion... give them beauty for ashes, The oil of joy for mourning, The garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; That they may be called trees of righteousness, The planting of the Lord, that He may be glorified."

Lots of scrumptious goodies and hot tea served with great fellowship and music.

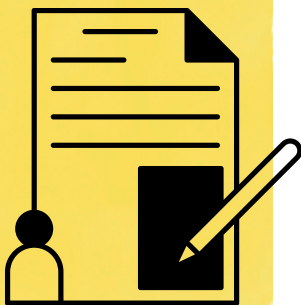
