



PRESIDER	We confess to you, Lord, all our past unfaithfulness: the pride, hypocrisy, and impatience of our lives, We confess to you, Lord.

PRESIDER	Our self-indulgent appetites and ways, and our exploitation of other people, We confess to you, Lord.
ALL	
PRESIDER	Our anger at our own frustration, and our envy of those more fortunate than ourselves, We confess to you, Lord.
ALL	
PRESIDER	Our intemperate love of worldly goods and comforts, and our dishonesty in daily life and work, We confess to you, Lord.
ALL	
PRESIDER	Our negligence in prayer and worship, and our failure to commend the faith that is in us, We confess to you, Lord.
ALL	
PRESIDER	Accept our repentance, Lord, for the wrongs we have done: for our blindness to human need and suffering, and our indifference to injustice and cruelty, Accept our repentance, Lord.
ALL	
PRESIDER	For all false judgements, for uncharitable thoughts toward our neighbours, and for our prejudice and contempt toward those who differ from us, Accept our repentance, Lord.
ALL	
PRESIDER	For our waste and pollution of your creation, and our lack of concern for those who come after us, Accept our repentance, Lord.
ALL	
PRESIDER	Restore us, good Lord, and let your anger depart from us; Hear us, Lord, for your mercy is great.
ALL
