John 4:21-24

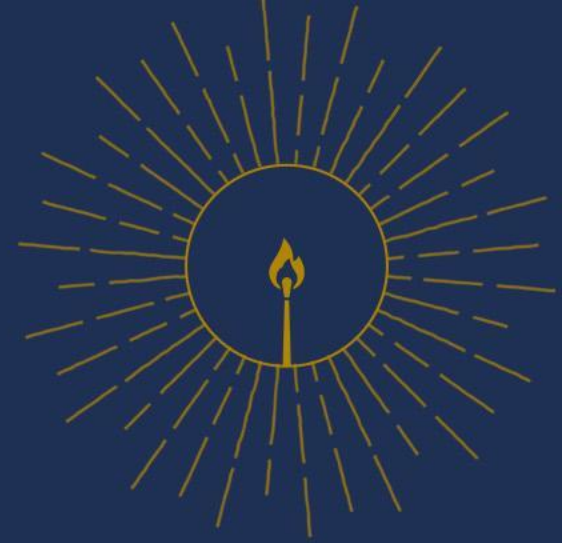
