Ash Wednesday

Our Ash Wednesday service will be Wednesday, February 18th at 6:00pm. Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of the Lenten Season in the Christian calendar. Lent is the season during which we are called to prepare our hearts, minds, & spirits for Easter's joy. At the Ash Wednesday service, we receive the "imposition of ashes." The ashes serve as a reminder of our mortality (ashes to ashes) and as a reminder of our need to repent for our sins. This ritual act in worship can be a powerful nonverbal and experiential way of participating in this season's call to repentance and reconciliation.
