Ash Wednesday, February 18th

Worship service at 7 pm



Ash Wednesday is the beginning of Lent. The official name is “Day of Ashes,” because of the practice of rubbing ashes on one’s forehead in the sign of a cross. Lent it is exactly 40 days (excluding Sundays) leading up to Easter.

The Bible never mentions Ash Wednesday—for that matter, it never mentions Lent. Lent is intended to be a time of self-denial, moderation, fasting, and the forsaking of sinful activities and habits. Ash Wednesday commences this period of spiritual discipline.

While the Bible does not mention Ash Wednesday, it does tell us of people in the Old Testament using dust and ashes as symbols of repentance and/or mourning (2 Samuel 13:19; Esther 4:1; Job 2:8; Daniel 9:3). The modern tradition of rubbing a cross on a person’s forehead helps to identify that person with Jesus Christ.

It is a good thing to repent of sinful activities, but it is something Christians should do every day, not just during Lent. It is a good thing to clearly identify oneself as a Christian, but, again, this should be an everyday identification, especially by our actions. And it is good to remember that no ritual can make one’s heart right with God, only God’s grace, mercy, and forgiveness can.

FROM THE COMMUNICATIONS MINISTRY TEAM

We have installed a new Hearing Assistance system from Listen Technologies. It uses a new technology called AuraCast. Unlike the WiFi system we tried earlier, this system has virtually no sound delay.

For those with hearing aids there are two primary methods for using this AuraCast based system:

1. Some hearing aids are already Auracast capable but may require your Audiologist to upgrade the firmware or switch it on. You would likely have a smart phone that has an application for your hearing aids to select our broadcast and set volume etc. This application would be updated to select a AuraCast broadcast which would then receive the MPC audio directly. This would be the preferred method and no additional equipment needed.
2. 2. If your hearing aids are not AuraCast capable then they would likely receive the MPC audio using the AuraCast receiver and neck loop like the WiFi system we had tried earlier. This AuraCast receiver with a loop that hangs around your neck transmits the audio directly to a hearing aid or implant that uses T-Coil technology. For most over-the-counter hearing aids this would work without any user changes. Some hearing aids need to have your Audiologist turn this option on as well.
3. 3. For those without hearing aids the AuraCast receiver will support any typical wired earbuds or earphones.

Finally, newer cell phones and wireless earbuds/headphones that support Auracast are just starting to hit the market but will be more readily available in the coming months. You might also see newer TV's (Samsung and LG) that are broadcasting a Auracast signal for hearing assistance so if you're shopping keep that in mind. For any of those devices look to see if they support AuraCast

We will be making adjustments to the sound system for several weeks to get the best result possible and always appreciate any feedback you may have.

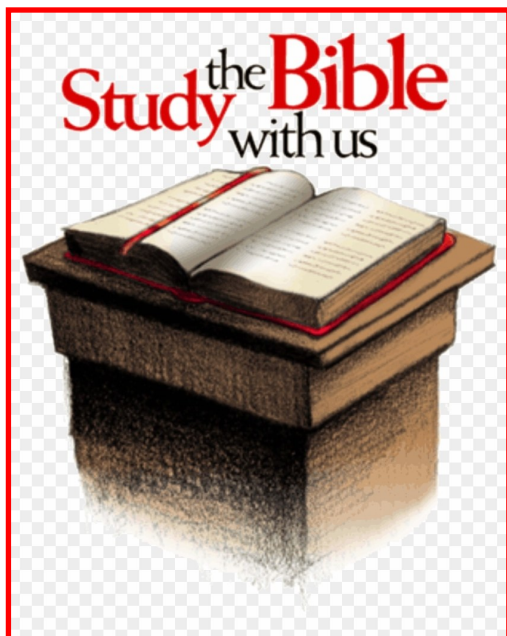
The Youth Group (6th through 12th graders)

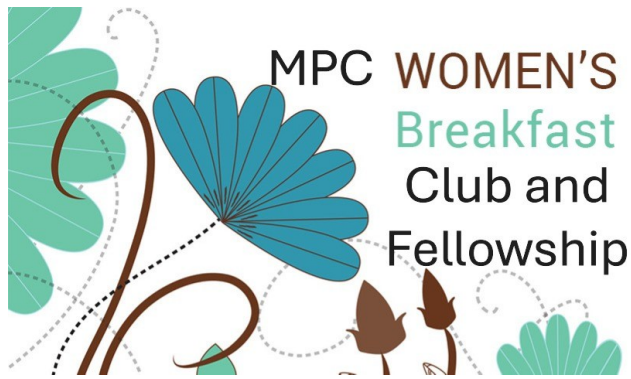

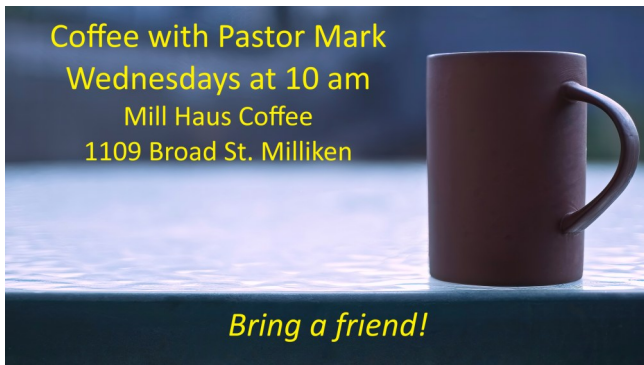

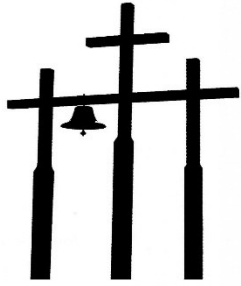
