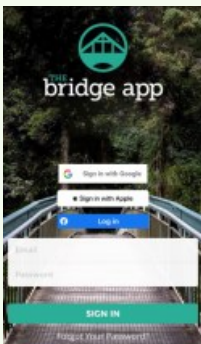


USED POSTAGE STAMPS FUNDRAISER Please save your used postage stamps and bring them to the church. They can be put into the jar at the Welcome Centre.

1st Offering — EBENEZER MINISTRIES This offering is used to cover day-to-day expenses of the church, fund the various ministries at Ebenezer, cover the salaries of staff, and contributes to the ministry shares that we are committed to as members of CRC Denomination.

2nd Offering: JALIA AFRICA FOUNDATION: Jalia's mission is to empower willing people to overcome the constraints of poverty by offering skills training, job creation and access to affordable credit opportunities that enable them to work their way out of poverty.

Wilbur H along with Calum H, Ryman H, Levi H and David P will be travelling to Suswa, Kenya in March to help build a multi purpose building with a kitchen at Victory County School that is home to 42 orphans and 80 students, some get bused and the rest walk to school. Meals are provided for the students and orphans. This week's offering will go to help purchase kitchen appliances for this building.

Next Week: DAYS FOR GIRLS (Local) Days for Girls is an international nonprofit organization that works to eliminate the stigma and limitations associated with menstruation so that women and girls have improved health education and livelihoods. To date DFG's has reached over 3.5 million women and girls.

Our local DFG's team has been hosting work bees here at Ebenezer three times a year for the past 10 years. We have made over 1000 kits which have been part of distributions to Kenya, Rwanda, Ethiopia, Guatemala and World Vision. World Vision sends kits to refugee camps.

Your generosity will help our local DFG's team provide supplies needed to make more kits.

There will be a DFG's work bee on Saturday February 21 here at Ebenezer. Everyone is welcome.
