Benevolent Offering The Flowers Liebenzell Mission Feb. 15: Pastor Alan Flowers is a member of our presbytery who retired from pastoring Spencer Mills OPC in Gowen. He and his wife Lisa have moved to Guam to do mission work at Pacific Islands University. Alan teaches at that Christian university, while Lisa mentors female students. Before pastoring here in Michigan, the Flowers had served in a related ministry in Chuuk, a Micronesian island (taking their three small children with them). Now that all their children are adults, their ministry has come full circle, returning to the Pacific Islands where they first began serving. Although the Flowers are fully self-funding their living expenses, they have requested that the churches of the presbytery to support their missions sending agency with \$500 per month for the administrative costs for the Flowers'

Pastor Search Update – The Session has appointed a committee of four elders to lead our pastoral search process (Elders Bill Huizinga, Bob Dornbos, Craig Baker, Ken Folkerts). As part of this work, the committee is developing a congregational profile that will provide important information about our church to prospective pastors. To ensure this profile reflects our shared vision and priorities, the committee will be gathering input from church leadership (elders and deacons) as well as from the congregation. In the near future, the congregation will receive a survey to share thoughts, ideas, and priorities. In addition, the committee has asked the Session to schedule a Town Hall meeting to hear directly from the congregation as a follow-up to the survey. **Please plan to attend the Town Hall meeting on Sunday, February 22, which will take place – in place of the education hour (No Sunday School), beginning immediately after our time of fellowship/coffee, following morning worship.**
