What an incredible display of God's beauty and power we had last week! It's amazing how God's creation can be so picturesque, but at the same time, bring our busy society to a crawl. Hopefully, our communication plan was successful, and everyone was well informed of schedule changes over the last 2 weeks. When the snow falls in the quantities that we saw this week, it makes travel more complicated. In fact, even walking in snow that deep becomes a challenge. It's not impossible to move forward, but you have to change your strategy. Instead of just lifting your foot a few inches and swiftly moving it forward, you have to slow down, be more deliberate with your steps, lift your legs higher, and plan each move. You get exhausted much quicker and have to take caution not to do too much. I'm reminded of something my dad told me recently, "As I've gotten older I've learned I can still do everything I could do before, I just have to do it slower." What great wisdom!

I think all this snow, as beautiful as it is, reminds us that we must not haste, but slow down. We should be diligent and plan carefully, but don't forget that He is always in control and will guide us. You may even slip and fall on your face (I did that at least once this week), but when your plan goes awry, He will pick you up. Perhaps it's the slowing down and being deliberate part that will allow us to hear Him when He is determining our steps. I know I need to apply this in my life. Too often, I rush and try to do things my way and take shortcuts (hence the face plant I had).

So, the next time you are trudging through snow (which is hopefully a long time from now), think about how you can slow down and take carefully planned steps, being steadfast in following Him. Think about keeping your eyes on Him as you examine the path and listen to Him each step of the way. He will give you the strength you need to make it through rough terrain. As Pastor Jon said in the sermon we replayed Sunday, God will put more on us than we can bear alone; we must learn to rely on Him, not ourselves.
