

Not everyone sees God as good, even if they acknowledge His power. Yet a God who is great but not good doesn't inspire devotion or trust—He only produces fear and anxiety. That's not the God we worship. That's not the God revealed in Scripture.

Today we'll return to Genesis 1 and discover the Hebrew word *tov*—appearing seven times as God evaluates His creation. This word means more than just "good" in our English sense. It means beautiful, excellent, complete, perfectly suited to its purpose. When God calls His creation *tov*, He reveals something essential about His own character.

We'll explore how Scripture demonstrates God's goodness through His character, His provision, and His presence. We'll see it in the stories of Joseph and the prodigal son. We'll discover it in psalms that invite us to "taste and see that the Lord is good."

But we'll also wrestle with the hard questions: Where is God's goodness when we're suffering? Can we trust Him when life is hard? And how should we respond to a God who is this good?

Join us as we learn to taste and see that the Lord is indeed good—all the time.
