CROSSWORD

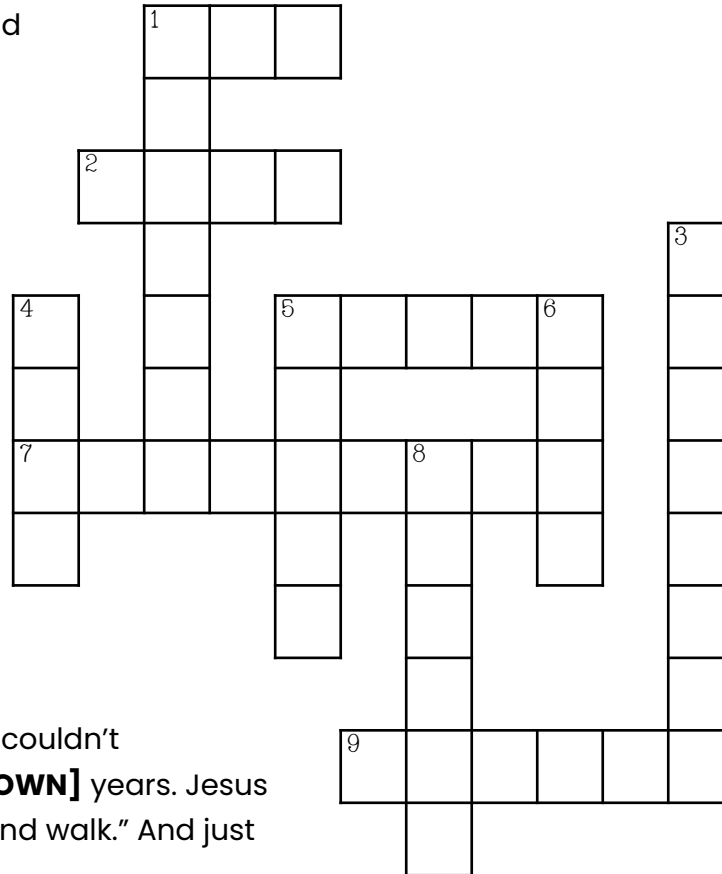
Use the story on the first page to complete the puzzle below.
