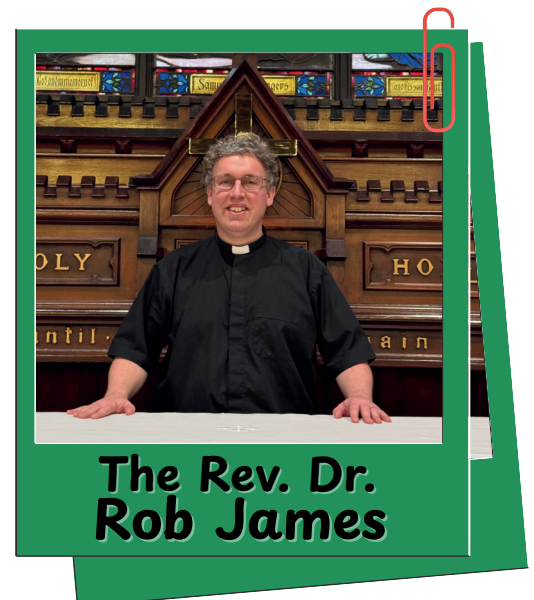
# ANGLICAN 101
